At the SE 1/16 corner set 5/8" x 30" iron pin with plastic cap mkd. HIBBS PLS 2234, 28" deep, from which:

An 8" Black Oak brs. N.11 W., 7.7 ft. A 6" White Oak brs. S.60 E., 6.3 ft. Both BT's scribed SE1/16S10BT.



SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

SURVEY FOR:

Kenneth R. Chapman, et al. 1183 Left Fork Humbug Creek Road Applegate, OR 97530

LOCATION:

A portion of the East one-half of Section 10, T.38 S., R.4 W., W.M., Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument the corners of the certain parcels of land.

PROCEDURE:

Tied controlling Section, one-quarter section and one-sixteenth section corners into a closed loop traverse. Compared measured values with those shown on the B.L.M. Official Field notes, with the results being acceptable. Fractionalized the East one-half of Section 10, set monuments and flagged the East & West lines of the subject property as shown on the attached map.

At the one-quarter corner common to Sections 3 & 10, found the monument as called for in the B.L.M. notes pulled out of the ground by persons unknown. Set 5/8" x 30" iron pin with plastic cap mkd. HIBBS PLS 2234, flush with ground, in same hole that B.L.M. monument had occupied from which:

A 5" White Oak brs. S.29°E., 22.1 ft. Scribe visible.(1983 B.L.M. rec. S.29 1/4°E., 33.5 lks.)

A 5" Black Oak brs. N.21°W., 50.8 ft. Scribe visible.(1983 B.L.M. rec. N.21 1/2°W., 77 lks.)

No other suitable BT's were available in area.

At the CN 1/16 corner set 5/8" x 30" iron pin with plastic cap mkd. HIBBS PLS 2234, 28" deep, from which:

An 8" Laurel brs. S.08°E., 25.1 ft. An 8" White Oak brs. N.35°E., 14.0 ft. Both BT's scribed CN1/16S10BT.

At the C 1/4 corner set 5/8" x 30" iron pin with plastic cap mkd. HIBBS PLS 2234, 28" deep, from which:

A 5" Pine brs. N.17°E., 11.2 ft, mkd. XBT. An 8" Fir brs. S.77°E., 23.9 ft, mkd. C1/4S10BT. A 6" Fir brs. S.04°W., 8.0 ft, mkd. C1/4S10BT. An 8" Fir brs. S.78°W., 4.2 ft, mkd. C1/4S10BT.

At the CS 1/16 corner set 5/8" x 30" iron pin with plastic cap mkd. HIBBS PLS 2234, 28" deep.

No suitable trees within limits.

At the C-W-NE 1/64 corner set $5/8" \times 30"$ iron pin with plastic cap mkd. HIBBS PLS 2234, 28" deep,

from which:
A 12" White Oak brs. S.22°W., 150.4 feet.
A 9" White Oak brs. S.77°W., 225.8 feet.
Both BT's scribed CWNE1/64S10BT.

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At the C-W-E 1/64 corner set 5/8" x 30" iron pin with plastic cap mkd. HIBBS PLS 2234, 28" deep,

from which:

A 6" Fir brs. N.84°E., 6.5 feet.

A 9" Fir brs. S.32°W., 7.2 feet.

Both BT's scribed CWE1/64S10BT.
