
## MAP OF SURVEY For CHARLES MCHENRY

PROCEDURE:


Control established during the course of Recorded Survey Nos. 10952, 11100, and 11157, which were accomplished through this office, was extended by random traverse to clients property. Survey Nos. 11100 and 11157 were used as the basis to complete the east property line. No attempt was made to determine the right of way line of Old Military Road and witness monuments were set approximately 30 feet from the existing centerline. Deed lines were computed and monuments set as shown on the attached map.
