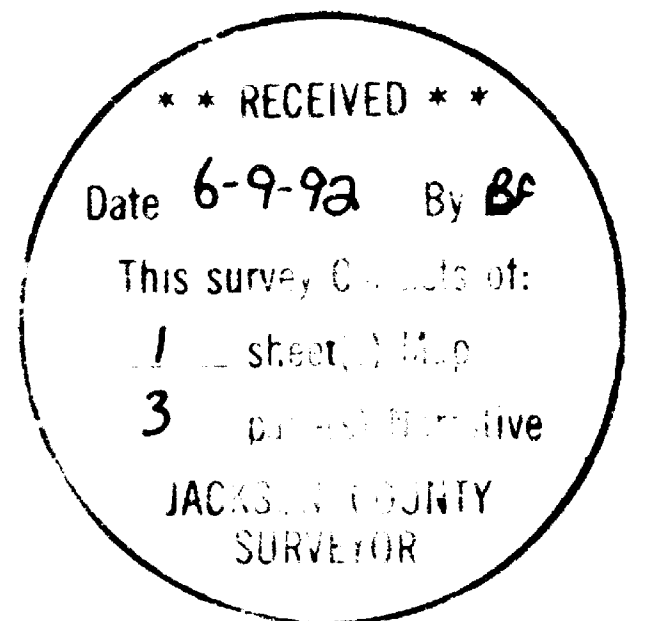

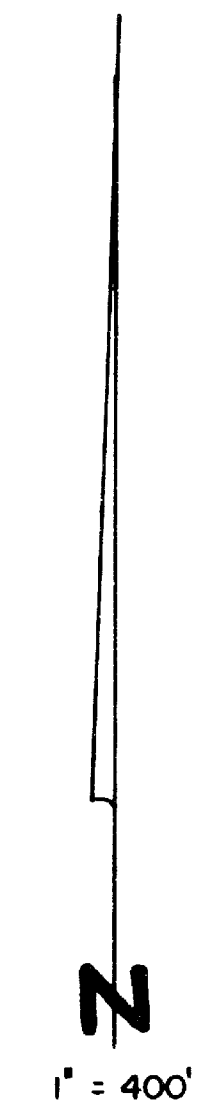

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

Location: Located in Parcel No. 3, Partition Plat No. P-50-1991, in the South half of the North half and the North half of the South half of Section 27, Township 38 South, Range 2 West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose: To survey and monument the Lot Line Adjustment as approved by Jackson County Department of Planning and Development, File No. 92-06-LLA

Procedure: Existing control, established in the performance of Filed Survey No. 12524, was utilized. Additional control was established tying in the controlling corners of Section 27 with a closed traverse. I then computed and established monuments as shown on the accompanying map.

The following accessories were tied during this survey. All measurements are to the center of the base of the trees found and to the center of the tree with a hub tack and brass washer in the lower blaze for trees taken;

Section Corner $\frac{21}{28} | \frac{22}{27}$

- Doug Fir, 26" diam., with healed blaze, bears N24°08'33"E 7.2 ft. (rec N24°E 10 lks., BLM re-estab notes)
- Doug Fir, 24" diam., with healed blaze, bears S49°34'19"E 70.5 ft. (rec S48°E 109 lks., BLM re-estab notes)
- Doug Fir, 26" diam., with healed blaze, bears S22°16'37"E 40.0 ft. (rec S22 1/4°E 60.5 lks., BLM re-estab notes)
- Doug Fir, 15" diam., with healed blaze, bears S0°58'16"W 79.4 ft. No record found.

1/4 Corner $\frac{22}{27}$

- Doug Fir, 14" diam., with healed blaze, bears S51°25'27"E 5.1 ft. No record found.
- Black Oak, dead and down, no scribe found, bears S34°55'58"W 58.4 ft. (rec S39 1/2°W 62.0 ft., County Surveyor re-estab notes)
- Doug Fir, 12" diam., with healed blaze, bears S46°18'33"W 47.4 ft. (rec S45 3/4°W 47.3 ft. to face of lower blaze, County Surveyor re-estab notes)
- Doug Fir, 8" diam., with healed blaze, bears N50°19'27"W 14.9 ft. (rec N51 1/4°W 14.8 ft. to face of lower blaze, County Surveyor re-estab notes)
