

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 205.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

KEP · HAD MINI-STORAGE

2561 Jacksonville Highway Medford, Oregon

LOCATION:

Donation Land Claim No. 76, and the southeast quarter of Section 26, T 37 S, R 2 W, WM.

Jackson County, Oregon

PURPOSE:

Locate and monument the boundaries of that parcel described in Instrument No. 89-01400 of

Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon

PROCEDURE:

Many deed descriptions of this parcel and adjacent properties called for an iron pipe, being east 1553.54 feet and north 447.34 feet from the southwest corner of Donation Land Claim No. 76. This monument has been searched for on this and several prior surveys and appears to be lost. It was therefore necessary to review deed records to determine the manner in which the controlling deed lines were created.


The primary controlling deed apparently is that recorded in 1892 as Volume 22, Page 630 of the deed records. The adjoining parcel to the east was then created as described in Volume 26, Page 413. This parcel was then subsequently divided in Volume 317, Page 149 and

Volume 317, Page 151.

The intent of the above mentioned deed descriptions was that the south boundaries coincide with the north boundary of the now abandoned Medford & Jacksonville Railway Company right of way. The right of way as determined by Surveys No. 5571 and 9080 was used for this survey. The boundaries of those two parcels described in Volume 317, Pages 149 and 151, were then determined by equal acreage division within the boundaries of that parcel described in Volume 26, Page 413.
