LOCATION: Southwest Quarter of Section 20, Northwest Quarter of Section 29

and the Northeast Quarter of Section 30, Township 39 South, Range

2 East, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To survey and monument the access road from Greensprings Highway

No. 66 to Jackson County's Emigrant Lake Park.

PROCEDURE: Research of the road records produced a survey of the subject road by Public Works in 1962 and 1968, and a map filed as 12/4. In attempting to retrace this survey, it became apparent the road as constructed was not going to fit very well. Therefore, it was decided to survey the road as constructed.

The first section of the road was held as monumented by Survey Nos. 3697 and 5242, being the location for old Highway No. 99. The balance of the road was then located and monumented as shown on the accompanying map.

The right of way for Greensprings Highway was determined from O.S.H.D. map dated 1957, revised in 1972 and filed in the County Surveyor's records as Map 99/4.

BASIS OF BEARINGS: U.S.G.S. triangulation Stations Klamath Junction and Pilot Rock, with grid bearing reduced in azimuth by -1°26'46".
