

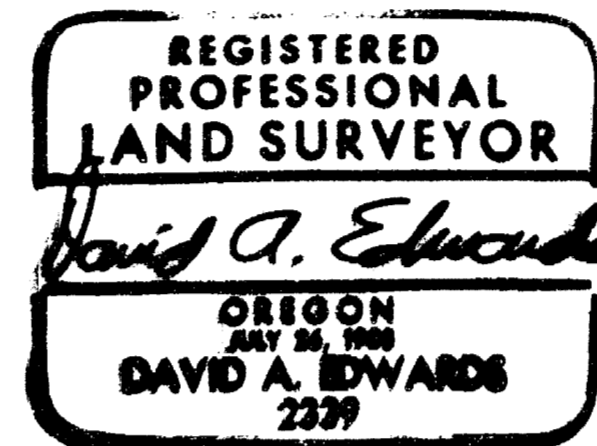

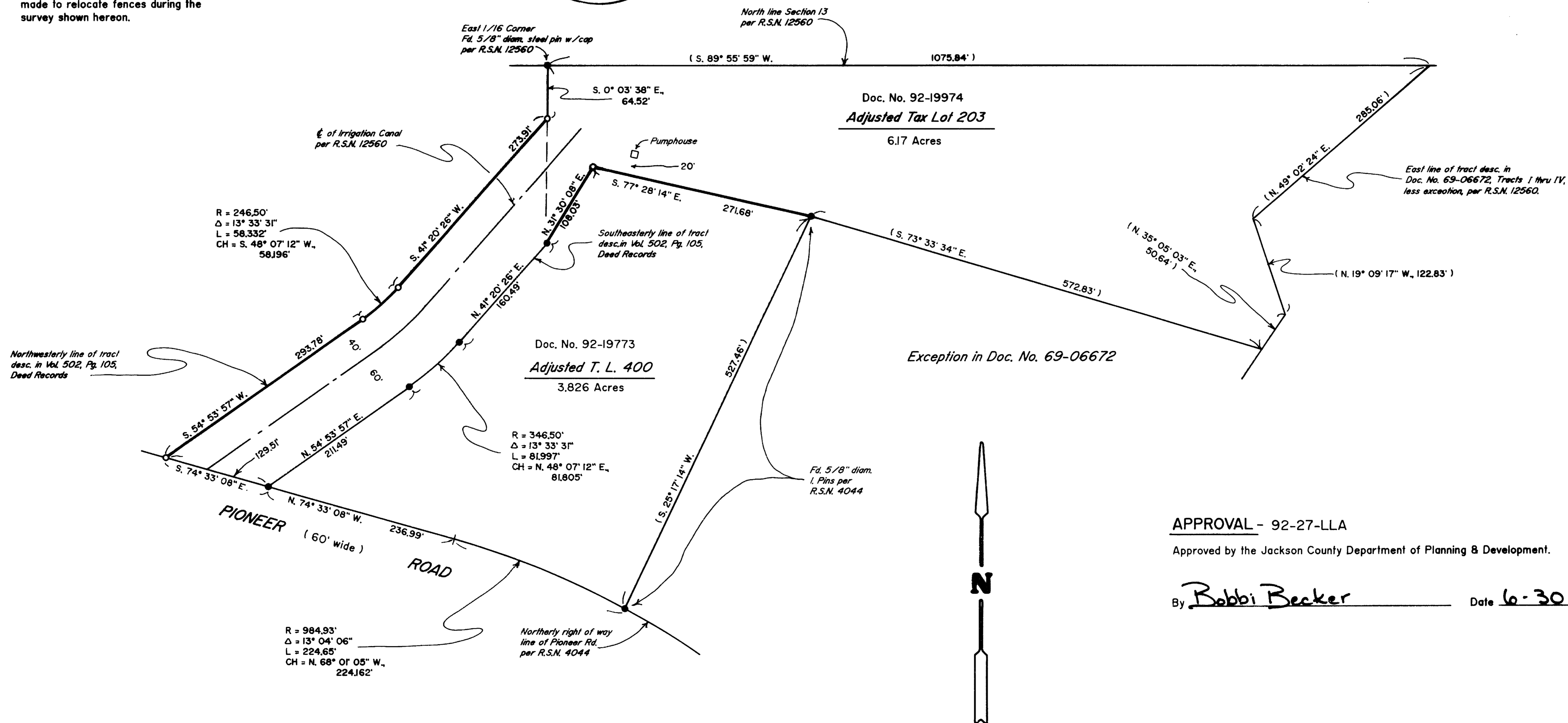

PURPOSE: Boundary Line Adjustment; Planning Dept. File
No. 92-27-LLA: To locate and monument the
NW'ly line of tract described in Vol. 502, Pg.
105, Deed Records and monument an adjusted
boundary between tax lots 203 and 400 as shown
on the accompanying plat and to prepare new
legal descriptions for those new parcels.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing existing control points and data
determined by this office during the execution
of Recorded Survey Number 12560, as well as
data found in the above noted document,
computed the location of the boundaries to be
monumented. The adjusted boundary was
monumented according to Planning Dept.
requirements and the clients preference.
