SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 205.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

Pat & Laurel Hansen 1930 Ashland Mine Road

Ashland, Oregon

LOCATION:

Southeast quarter of Section 6, Township 39 South,

Range 1 East, WM., Jackson County, Oregon

PURPOSE:

Locate and monument the boundaries of the client's property as described in Instrument No. 90-09750 of

the Official Records of Jackson County.

PROCEDURE:

The north and west boundaries of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 6 were determined by using the brass cap monument set on Survey No. 9681 at the proportionate position of the east quarter of Section 6, and the monuments shown as set on

Surveys No. 12661 and 12756.

In attempting to locate the right of way of Ashland Mine Road, a search was made for the two madrone bearing trees at Mile Post 1 as described in the 1892 survey notes outlined in Jackson County Road Record Volume 3, Page 34. The burned out remains of two large madrone stumps were located. The centerline of the existing roadway and the two stump remains were correlated with the record surveyed centerline description to get a "best fit". Assuming that the roadway in the vicinity of the curve had been shifted to accommodate more modern transportation, the resulting centerline fit quite well with the "asbuilt" centerline. The stumps were then considered to be the remains of the bearing trees and record distances used to determine the location of the centerline at Mile Post 1.

AFFIDAVIT OF CORRECTION

Be it hereby noted with regard to Survey No. 13091 as filed with the Office of the Jackson County Surveyor, the following correction should be made to the map of said survey:

At the northeast corner of the property, which was the subject of the survey and shown thereon as described in Instrument No. 90-09750 of the Official Records, a witness monument is shown as being set S00°00"02" E 1.00 ft. from said northeast corner. The distance should be corrected on the map to read 0.50 ft. to the witness monument.

Also, the following information should be added to the map to clarify the location of the calculated centerline of Ashland Mine Road.

- From the brass cap monumenting the proportioned E 1/4 of Section 6, the calculated centerline of said road bears S 89°52'58" W 2.63 ft., and from that centerline point the first road PI bears S 00°49' 15" E 209.66 ft.
- From the iron pin monument set at the southeast corner of the subject tract (being on the northerly boundary of the right of way of Ashland Mine Road, and from which an iron pin set at an angle point on the property boundary bears N 76°37'02" W 300.75 ft.) the PI of the calculated road centerline bears S 68°47'43" E 31.63 ft. From this PI, said centerline bears N 71°43'45" E as shown.


