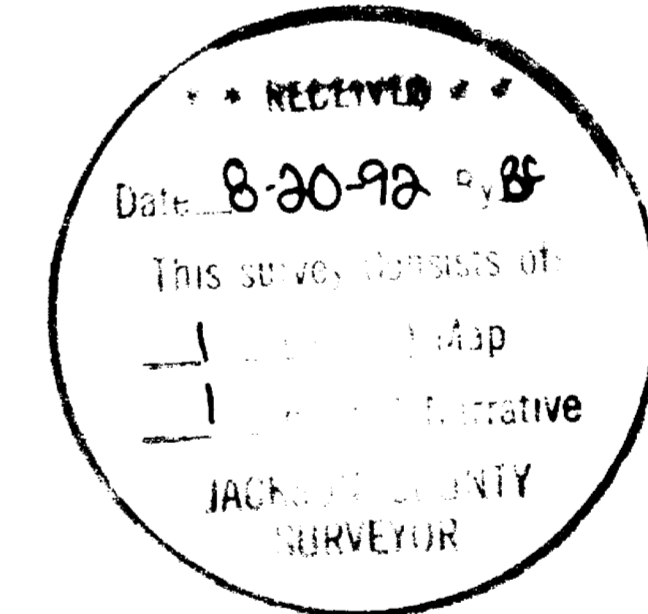
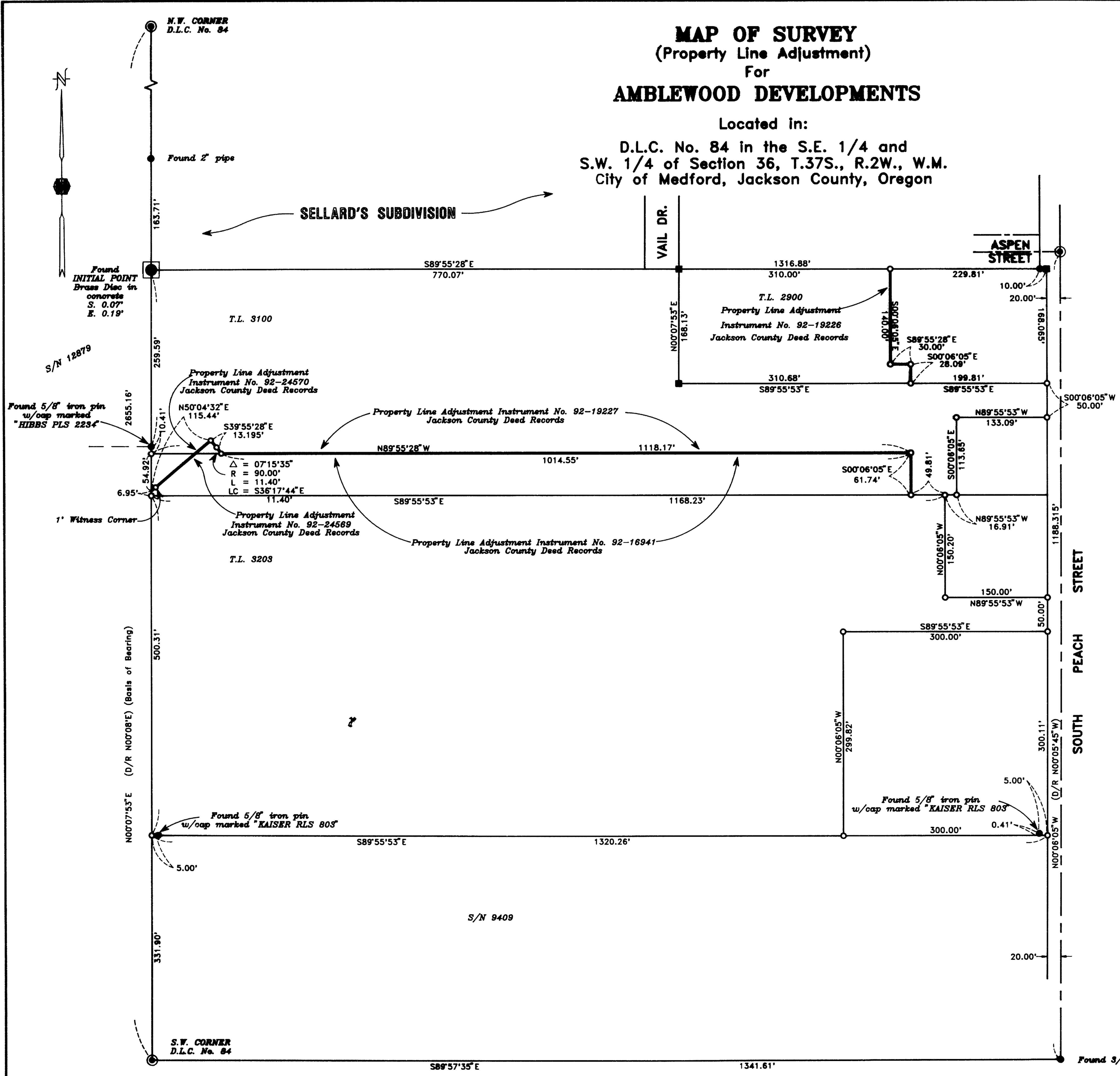


MAP OF SURVEY (Property Line Adjustment) For AMBLEWOOD DEVELOPMENTS

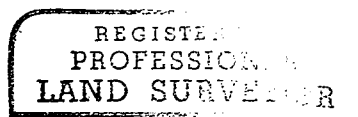
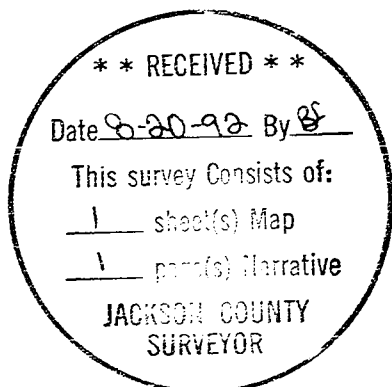
Location: Donation Land Claim No. 84 in the Southeast one-quarter (1/4) and the Southwest one-quarter (1/4) of Section 36 in Township 37 South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, City of Medford, Jackson County, Oregon

Purpose: To survey and monument the adjusted boundary lines of the subject property as directed by client and approved by the City of Medford

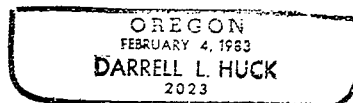
Procedure: Utilizing a one-second theodolite and electronic distance measuring equipment, a control traverse was run tying found monuments as shown on the attached map. Monuments found at the Northwest and Southwest corners of Donation Land Claim No. 84, along with monuments found along the South line of Sellard's Subdivision were held for control. The centerline of South Peach Street was determined from found monuments as shown. The location of the missing corners was then computed and monuments were set as shown.
