Survey Narrative To Comply With O.R.S. 209.250

Survey For:

1971 Dead Indian Road Ashland, OR 97520

Location:

A portion of D.L.C. No. 38 in the N.W. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec. 7, T.39 S., R.2 E., W.M., Jackson

County, Oregon.

Purpose:

To survey and monument the northerly and easterly lines of tax lot 301 as requested by the client.

Procedure:


Tied between the Northwest and Southwest section corners of Section 7 for basis of bearings. Calculated a proportion position for the N.W. corner of D.L.C. No. 38 as shown. Held the North line of D.L.C. No. 38 parallel with the North line of Section 7 as shown on Survey No. 10506 and went deed distance. Held deed bearing and distance on the Easterly line of the tax lot. Since this survey did not attempt to determine the Northerly line of Dead Indian Road, the Southeasterly pin set is a witness corner. Monuments found and those set are as shown on the attached map.
