## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

Location:

Northeast one-quarter (1/4) of Section 31 and the Northwest one-quarter (1/4) of Section 32 in Township 37 South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, City of

Jacksonville, Jackson County, Oregon

Purpose:

To survey and monument a Minor Land Partition as approved by the City of Jacksonville Planning Commission

Procedure: Utilizing a one-second theodolite and electronic measuring equipment a control traverse was run tying found monuments as shown on the attached map. The North half of the Southeast one-quarter (1/4) of the Northeast one-quarter (1/4) had been previously surveyed per Recorded Survey No. 6432. The corners established by that survey were apparently determined by a projection or computation based on monuments found from Survey No. 1673 and not from a correct section breakdown.


The clients' property is described in Instrument No. 89-16439 of the Official Records in Jackson County, Oregon and includes a Parcel 2 being "an unnumbered fractional lot lying Northwesterly of Lot One (1) in Block Sixty (60) of the Town (now City) of Jacksonville.....". This "unnumbered fractional lot does not appear on the copy of the "Map of Jacksonville" which was filed with the County Clerk in 1871. The County Surveyor has this same map filed as page 249 in his Plat book. With the help of the County Surveyor we found a copy of a map of Jacksonville filed as V/C-13 which does show Block 60 with an unnumbered fractional lot; however, this map was not dated or signed. With additional research and the gracious help of Professional Surveyor Mark Boyden, a copy of a "Map of Jacksonville" was found, dated February 25, 1864 which also shows an unnumbered fractional lot in Block 60. With Mr. Boyden's approval, a copy of this map as been given to the County Surveyor. I have based my survey of Block 60 on this map.


After evaluating the monuments found, the new lot lines were computed and monuments were set as shown on the attached map.
