

## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 205.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

PURPOSE:

Locate and monument the boundaries of the client's

ownership, being Tax Lots 1801 & 1802.

PROCEDURE:

survey. monumented.

Control points around the exterior of Section 6 were located and measured to, as shown on the map of center 1/4 corner was then determined and Deed research revealed that the entire northwest The quarter of the section was at one time acquired by Jackson County by tax foreclosure. The County subsequently sold off the "S $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ " of Section 6, and then at a later date sold the "N $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW¼". The first parcel was then divided by selling off the "E½ of

the  $S_2^+$  of the NW $_2^+$  of Section 6.

This presents the question as to whether the intent was to convey by acreage, midpoints along the side lines, or fractional aliquot parts of the northwest quarter. Researching of boundary law textbooks indicated that the proper interpretation would be an intent to convey by acreage. This was the method used for this survey, but there was still the question as to placement of the division line and its alignment. The method used, which seemed to be the most equitable to all affected property owners, was to place the division line at a proportionate bearing in relation to the bearings of the corresponding sides. At the center quarter of Section 6, the following trees were blazed and marked "C $\frac{1}{4}$ " in the upper blaze and "BT" in the lower blaze:

6" dia. fir bears N 59° W 15.09 ft.

11" dia. madrone bears S 4° W 15.64 ft.

14" dia. fir bears S 87° W 34.61 ft.

8" dia. fir bears N 11° W 14.07 ft.

Bearings were taken with hand compass, to the center of the tree at the lower blaze. Distances were measured to a nail and washer at the side center of the tree at the top of the root crown.

> Basis of bearing: Filed Survey No. 5113, along the south boundary of Section 6.

## AFFIDAVIT OF CORRECTION

Be it hereby noted with regard to SN 13297, filed in the Jackson County Surveyors Office on December 29, 1992, that new information provided by the Bureau of Land Management has affected the status of the filed survey.

During the course of survey for SN 13297, Section 6 was subdivided to locate the boundaries of the northwest quarter. The monument set to represent the northwest corner of Section 6 was established by the County Surveyor in 1988. The property boundaries being surveyed and marked were then determined in relation to said boundaries of the northwest quarter section.

The corner position as monumented by the County Surveyor in 1988 was a perpetuation of evidence found of the work of the General Land Office contract surveyor Earnest Rands in 1910. In 1998 the BLM did an extensive resurvey of the location of the northwest corner of Section 6, and determined the County Surveyor monumented position, therefore Rand's position, to be in error. The BLM then established the section corner position by double proportionate measurement.

The BLM monumented township corner, according to their field notes, is S 61°06'00" E 2.478 chains (163.55 ft.) from the 1988 County Surveyor monument. This change of location has the effect of nullifying all monuments set by SN 13297, with the exception of the center 1/4 corner.
