WAP OF SURVEY

4. An unrecorded 1-1/2" iron pipe projecting 8" above ground was found bearing S 00°50'10" W, a distance of 60.00 feet from the section corner brass cap.

A closed field traverse was run from the 1/4 corner to the section corner and returned to the 1/4 corner. The traverse was adjusted and an offset was calculated to set the 5/8" x 30" rebar.
