Set a % inch diameter x 30 inch long iron pin, 3" deep, with orange plastic cap marked "R ROBERTS LS 165". A  $\frac{1}{2}$ " dia., 4" tall bolt at the top southeast corner of a concrete irrigation box bears N30^31'W 3.38 ft. A  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6" tall pipe at the center of the west end of the irrigation box bears N75°56'W 16.42 ft. The 1/16 corner falls at the north edge of an unimproved access road.

other road was not actually on the property as indicated in the description, but south of the property. Since the instrument was a bargain and sale deed between the Stranbergs and Eshoos, I contacted John Stanberg, Jr. and George Eshoo. They both indicated that the roadway referred to in the deed was the access road from Valley View Road easterly to the Eshoo property in Section 20. In mapping the north edge of the ditch cut for this road, it was found to coincide very closely with the south boundary of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 19. This 1/16th line was therefore used as the south boundary of the "20 foot, 6 inch" strip. The south boundary of the subject parcel was therefore placed at 20.50 feet north of and parallel with the 1/16th line.

The following described monuments were set and references taken:

1/4 Section corner between Sections 29 and 30.

Each pin is 3" deep, with an orange plastic cap marked "R ROBERTS LS 1656". The most northerly corner of a small barn bears S70°17'W 51.12 ft. A 4" steel pipe roof support at the most easterly corner of the barn bears S17°42'W 46.00 ft. The corner lies 4 feet west of a north-south pipe and smooth wire fence.

Section corner common to Sections 19, 20, 29, and 30.

Set a 1.5" x 36" galvanized iron pipe, 6 inches deep, with 2.5" brass cap marked

Each pin is 3" deep, with an orange plastic cap marked "R ROBERTS LS 1656". A headless concrete nail, driven flush with the top surface of a concrete irrigation box, bears S40°10'E 8.40 feet. The nail is 10" east and 12" north of the southwest corner of the irrigation box.

1/4 Section corner between Sections 19 and 20.

Set a 1.5" x 36" galvanized iron pipe, exposed 2 inches, in a mound of stone, with 2.5" brass cap marked

Each pin is topped with an orange plastic cap marked "R ROBERTS LS 1656".

## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 205.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

Robert and Sylvia Bieniek

LOCATION:

Southeast quarter of Section 19, Township 38 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson

County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

Locate and monument the exterior boundaries and partition lines for that minor partition approved by Jackson County Planning File No. 91-36-NF/91-24-MP.

The boundary of the parent tract was controlled on PROCEDURE: the east side by the east boundary of Section 19. The location of this section line was not apparent due to a lack of available monumentation. No information or evidence could be found for the location of the southeast corner of Section 19, nor for the quarter section corners to the west, north and south. Available section corner and quarter corner control for proportioning was found as shown on the map. The quarter corner between Sections 29 and 30 was determined from the calls given in the original notes of the surveys of Donation Land Claim 44 and 45. From these original notes, the 1/4 corner was determined from the northwest corner of Donation Land Claim 45 as being record East 920.70 feet, and record North 491.70 feet. This position falls 0.50 feet east of a northsouth line drawn between the nearest available public land survey corners, being the northeast corner of said Section 19 on the north, and the southeast corner of said Section 30 to the south. This point falls 98 feet north of Meyers Creek. The original notes call for "a dry branch "being 184.8 feet south of the original corner. Natural and manmade changes in the location of the stream

bed probably account for a large portion of the difference.

The southeast corner of Section 19 was then determined by double proportionate measurement, and the quarter corners on the south and east boundaries of Section 19 determined by single proportionate measurement. The resultant distance of 2659.68 feet, from the southeast corner of Section 19 northerly to the East 1/4 corner, compares very well with the measurements shown in the notes of a survey of that line by M.L. McCall in May of 1887. His notes show a distance of 2659.8 feet. (City of Ashland Field Book A, page 130).

The northeast boundary of the parent tract was determined along the centerline of the Talent Irrigation District East Canal. Measurements were taken along the canal and a geometric centerline computed.

The property is bounded on the west by Valley View Road. No monumentation could be found along the existing roadway, or any documentation to accurately determine the right of way location. For the purpose of this survey, the physical centerline of the present roadway was used to determine a centerline, and the right of way boundary 30 feet east of this line.

The south boundary was described as being along the north boundary of a "... strip of land twenty feet six inches (20'6") in width ... northerly of and running adjacent to the existing road located on the following described property, ... ". The description, given in Jackson County Instrument No. 76-03443, then described the property which is hereby being surveyed. existing road on the property (shown on the map) did not seem to fit the circumstance for determining a property line.
