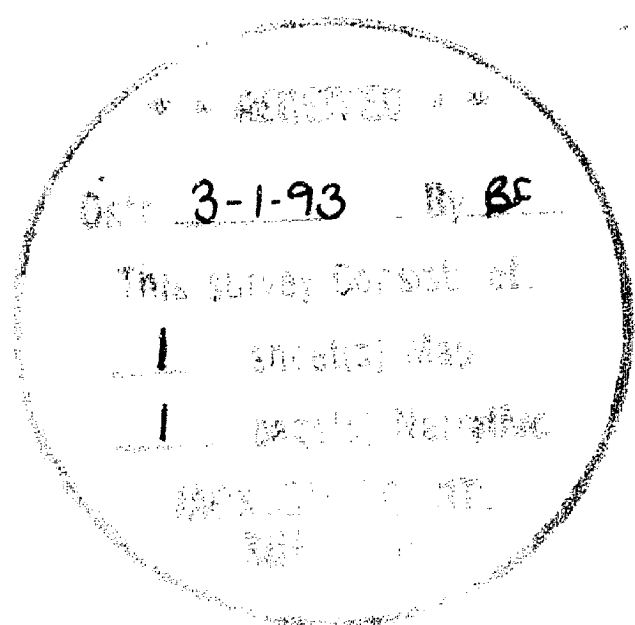

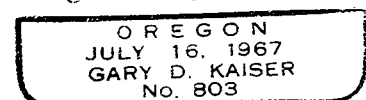
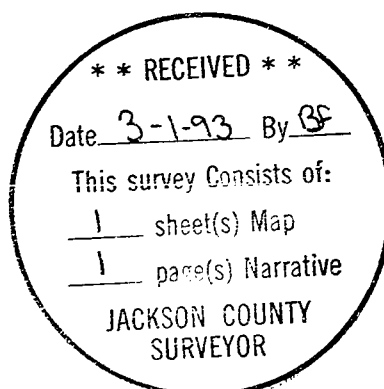
BASIS OF BEARINGS: Filed Survey No. 11934

DATE: February 19, 1993

PURPOSE: To monument (with witness corners)
the new boundary created by approved
property boundary adjustment County
File No. 92-110-LLA.

PROCEDURE: Monuments along the South boundary
of tract described in Vol. 264, Page 629 D.R. have
apparently been destroyed by river flooding (both surveys
were prior to the 1964 flood). The SW corner of said tract
was monumented by running from the 3/4" iron pipe located at
the NW corner through the 5/8" iron pin set midway on the
West boundary on Filed Survey No. 1334 as shown on the
annexed map. Record angle was turned at the SW corner to
establish the South boundary.

The new boundary created was the center of the main
channel of the Rogue River and was monumented with witness
corners as shown.



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
