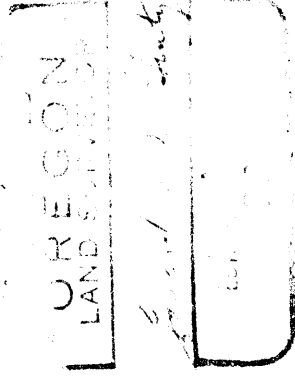

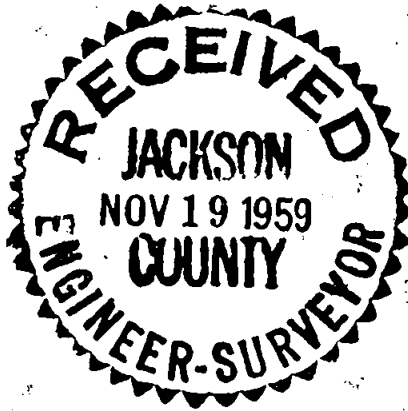

BASIS OF BEARING: Solar observation

PRECEDENCE OF SURVEY:

The westerly line was determined from monuments found along the accepted old line, found a 3/4 inch iron pipe at the northerly end and a stone at the fence corner, being accepted for many years as the center of Section 32. The other boundaries of parcels shown were designated by client. The 30 foot private road easement not monumented, also designated by my client. Previous survey No. 1030, bearing was determined from record, which is 0° 14' anti clockwise from this survey.
