



BASIS OF BEARING: SURVEY #11925 EAST HALF OF SOUTH LINE

PURPOSE:

TO MARK AND POST THE BOUNDARIES OF MEDCO LAND IN THE SAID SECTION 28 AS SHOWN ON THE PLAT TO ACCOMPANY THIS NARRATIVE.

PROCEDURE:

A SEARCH OF THE RECORDS REVEALED THAT CONTROLLING CORNERS HAD BEEN REMONUMENTED BY EITHER JACKSON COUNTY SURVEYOR OR HAROLD L. CENTER REGISTERED PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR. I RAN A CLOSED TRAVERSE AROUND THE SOUTH HALF SECTION 28. I THEN CALCULATED SUBDIVISION OF THE SOUTH HALF OF SECTION 28, AND SET MONUMENTS AND POSTED LINE AS SHOWN ON THE PLAT TO

ACCOMPANY THIS NARRATIVE.
