An 8" Black Oak scribed "SW 1/16 S3-BT" bears North 27° 32' West, 18.1 feet to the center.

The parcel descriptions had been carefully prepared not to overlap or create gaps, with the overplus taken up between the East line of the Bruce D. Meeds parcel and the East line of William C. Ellison parcel.

No attempt was made to determine the true centerline of Forest Creek Road with witness corners set to control the parcel lines running Northerly from said road. At the Southwest corner of the Wayne Andrew Meeds, Jr. property around the old 1-acre school tract, monuments set by Meeds at the Southwest, Northwest and Northeast corners of the 1-acre tract were disregarded, but all fell within 1-foot of the true corners as monumented on this survey.
