

At the West one-sixteenth corner on the South boundary of Section 34, found a 5/8" rebar with plastic cap marked "D. McMahan LS 1913" from which I mark the following trees:

A 8" white oak scribed "W 1/16 S 3-BT" bears S 36° 58' E, 24.6'

A 6" white oak scribed "W 1/16 S 34-BT" bears N 61° 20' E, 59.6'

At the centerwest one-sixteenth corner to Section 34 set a 1" X 36" galvanized iron pipe exposed 4" with plastic cap marked "Kaiser RLS 803" from which:


A 14" fir scribed "CW 1/16 S 34-BT" bears S 37° 17' E, 25.8'

A 6" pine scribed "CW 1/16 S 34-BT" bears N 79° Ø4' W, 8.7'

At the West one-sixteenth corner on the North boundary of Section 34, set a 1" X 36" galvanized iron pipe exposed 4" with a plastic cap marked "Kaiser RLS 803" from which:

A 8" laurel scribed "W 1/16 S 34-BT" bears S 45° 29' E, 39.5'

A 5" laurel scribed "W 1/16 S 27-BT" bears N 15° 54' E, 3.8'

The 14" cedar scribed on S.N. 1597, now 30" with healed blazes, bears N 32° 15' E, 44.7' to the center

 $(S.N. 1597 = N 31^{\circ} 15' E, 45.0')$ 

 $(S.N. 3446 = N 31^{\circ} 28' E, 44.7')$ 

The 10" fir scribed on S.N. 1597, now 24" with healed blazes, bears N 46° 30' W, 28.8' to the center

(S.N. 1597 = N 36° 40' W, 29.6')

(S.N. 3446 = N 46° 59' W, 28.7')

An unmarked 12" alder bears S 30" 45' E, 6.2'

The Southwesterly corner of a building bears S 59° Ø6' E, 178.5'

After re-establishing the West quarter corner to Section
34 as set on Filed Survey No. 1597, the remaining monuments
indicated as found on the annexed map were tied by EDM
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
