SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH CHAPTER 209, PARAGRAPH 250, OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR: Boise Cascade Timber and Wood Products Group

P.O. Box 100

Medford, Oregon 97501

In Section 5 & 6, T. 33 S., R. 1 W., W.M., in LOCATION:

Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To locate and monument the corners of Boise

> Cascade land in Secs. 5 & 6 and to blaze trees and place metal tags marking the boundaries of

said lands as shown on the attached map.

PROCEDURE: Control traverses were run to tie in the

controlling Government corners as shown. The South 1/4 corner of Section 6 was computed from

ties to the B.L.M. bearing trees as the

monument itself is gone. According to my ties,

the B.L.M. cap for the East 1/4 corner of

Section 6 is out of position by nearly 7 feet.

The North 1/16 on the East line is within 1.98

feet however. I therefore use the computed position for the East 1/4 corner and accept the 1/16 corner as shown. A search by ourselves and

the County Surveyor's personnel could find no original evidence of the North 1/4 corner of Section 6. The subdivision of Section 6 was then computed as shown. The true lines were then marked and trees were blazed if they were within 3' of the line. Aluminum tags mkd. "P/L BCC" were set at maximum 100' intervals

along these lines. Bearing trees were marked according to the 1973 B.L.M. Manual and measured to center of tree at root crown.

Monuments set on this survey consist of 5/8" x

30" steel pins with red plastic caps mkd.

"D.A. EDWARDS-LS 2339". The bearing trees are

situated as follows:

At the South 1/16 cor. between Secs. 5 & 6: A 7" diam. Fir brs. S. 24° 30' E., 13.9 ft. A 5" diam. Fir brs. N. 82° W., 13.65 ft.

At the SE 1/16 corner of Section 6: A 10" diam. Fir brs. N. 29° E., 16.85 ft. An 8" diam. Fir brs. N. 84° E., 20.20 ft.
