

PURPOSE:

To monument tract described in Vol. 553, Page 320 D.R. (Current deed,

Inst. No. 89-21524 O.R.)

PROCEDURE:

The subject tract boundaries are

partially controlled by subdivision boundaries of the NE % of Section 3. The North, West and East quarter corners were tied and a position for the South quarter corner, which falls in the river, was computed via Filed Survey Nos. 8062, 11834, 12533 and 12987. As is noted on the annexed map, the Northeast corner of Section 3 was not tied on this survey, a position for it was computed from Filed Survey No. 8062 and verified by Filed Survey No. 4393.

The West boundary of the subject tract is the West boundary of the East-half of the NE % Section 3 (also the West boundary of Gov't Lot 1). The West boundary of Gov't Lot 1 is shown to be monumented on Filed Survey No. 1731. The 5/8" rebar set on said survey on this boundary appears to be the only remaining monument and it is found to be 2.05' West of line.

The South boundary of the subject tract was located per tract described in Inst. No. 69-02249 O.R..

The East boundary was located per tract described in
