PURPOSE:

To locate and monument the boundaries of tax lot 600 as shown on the accompanying plat.

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing for control the found monuments per Surveys Numbered 5853, 9007 and City street center monuments, as well as deed record data and evidence as detailed herein, computed the positions for the boundaries as shown. Tracts in this area appear to have been monumented and conveyed according to an unrecorded subdivision plat titled Carter Heights Addition.
