

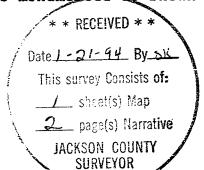
D.L.C. boundary from said intersection point checks the deed record distance to the Northeast corner of D.L.C. No. 59, measure = 1187.28 and Deed Record = 1188.52 feet.

A proportion for the East-West lot dimensions of Lots 7 through 13 was developed between the SW corner of D.L.C. No. 55 and the NW corner of D.L.C. No. 56, 1322.86 measure = 1326.0 plat record. The bearings for the North-South lot lines were all ran parallel to line between the SW corner of D.L.C. No. 55 and the NE corner of D.L.C. No. 53 which agrees with the procedure shown on the plat.

There appeared to be 3 possibilities for determining the bearing of the 35-foot wide dedicated roadway.

- A. Plat record angle off a line between the SW corner of D.L.C. No. 55 and the NE corner of D.L.C. No. 53. This procedure was not used since other angles on the plat did not check, namely the angle a the NE corner of D.L.C. No. 53.
- B. Run the street from NW corner of D.L.C. No. 55 parallel with the North boundary of D.L.C. No. 59 since the plat record distances for the North-South boundaries of Lots 7, 8 and 9 are all equal which lead to this possibility. This procedure was not used because it shortened the North-South boundaries of the lots on the North side of the roadway, especially those at the West end of the roadway (Lots 5 and 6), what seemed an exorbitant amount, approximately 20 feet while the North-South boundaries of the Lots on the South side of the roadway remained near the record distance.
- C. Use a proportion between the North boundary of D.L.C. No. 53 and the North boundary of D.L.C. No. 59 on distance along the West boundary of the plat to determine the Northing for the West end of the roadway and run Easterly from there to the NW corner of D.L.C. No. 55. This is the procedure used, lot area shortages were more evenly distributed giving a better over-all relationship plat record to measured.

Having completed the procedures hereinbefore discussed to determine the needed deed boundaries to locate the West boundary of Tax Lot 488 and to determine the lot boundaries of GRAND VIEW ORCHARD TRACTS, the desired tract boundaries were monumented as shown on the annexed map.

PURPOSE:

To monument the corners of tract described in Inst. No. 83-02118 O.R. and also to monument the West boundary of Lots 6 and 7 of GRAND

VIEW ORCHARD TRACTS.

PROCEDURE:

Closed Loop E.D.M. Traverses were

ran tieing found monument. The North boundary of D.L.C. No. 53 was located from County Surveyor re-established D.L.C. corners for the East end and monuments set on Filed Survey No. 9217 as shown. The Northwest corner of GRAND VIEW ORCHARD TRACTS was located plat record distance West from the NE corner of D.L.C. No. 53 since there was no found monuments to use as a basis for proportioning.

The Northwest corner of tract described in Vol. 36 Page 528 D.R. (also being the Northeast corner of tract described in Vol. 34, Page 95 D.R.) was located at deed record distance West from the Northeast corner of D.L.C. No. 53. Subsequent conveyances have used the same procedure. Record angle was turned off the North boundary of D.L.C.No. 53 to determine the Westerly boundary of tract described in Vol. 36, Page 528 D.R. (Easterly boundary of tract described Vol. 34, Page 95 D.R.) and the line ran Southeasterly to intersect the North boundary D.L.C. No. 59. The distance Easterly on said
