LOCATION: In the SE 1/4 of Section 18, Township 34
South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian,
Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To monument the North and East line of the S
1/2 of the SE 1/4 of Section 18.

DATE: January 26, 1994

BASIS OF BEARING: Based upon the East line of the SE 1/4 of
Section 18, per B.L.M. unofficial Cadastral
Survey, date 1992.

PROCEDURE: Utilizing a Nikon A-10 Total Station, tied the
E 1/4 and the SE corner of Section 18, as
shown. Using a copy of the B.L.M. unofficial
Cadastral Survey map, I computed the CS 1/16
position. I then ran N 00°04'30" East along
the true line from the SE corner of Section 18
1323.42 feet, to the CS 1/16 corner common to
Sections 18 and 17, at said corner set a 5/8"x
30" rebar with a yellow plastic cap marked "
TEMPLIN LS 2359 ", from which I scribe the
following bearing trees:

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JACKSON COUNTY
SURVEYOR

A Black Oak, 15" diameter bears N 78 1/2° W,
17.4 feet, scribed "E1/16S18" "BT".
A White Oak, 13" diameter bears S 41 1/2° W,
68.6 feet, scribed "E1/16S18" "BT".

I then ran S 89°44'02" W on true line, 2637.58
feet to a B.L.M. brass cap, being the CS 1/16
corner of Section 18, from which I find the
following bearing trees:

A Douglas fir, 11" diameter, with partially
healed blazes, bears S 41° W, 21.6 feet.
A Douglas fir, 19" diameter, with partially
healed blazes, bears S 43° E, 57.1 feet.

I scribe the following bearing tree:

A Cedar, 10" diameter bears S 88° W, 57.9
feet, scribed "CS1/16S18" "BT".
