

History of original monument establishment:

Being a monument 30 feet SOUTH of the N.W. corner of Lot 5, Section 25, Township 37 South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, as shown upon the Map of Highland Park Addition to the City of Medford, Oregon, recorded in Volume 1 of Plats, Page 153, Records of Jackson County, Oregon.

Description of monument evidence found:

Found 3/4" iron pin in concrete in monument well at the intersection of West Main Street with Columbus Avenue (NORTH).

Description of monument used to perpetuate the original location of this monument:

Utilizing the above found location, set 2" diameter iron pipe with 2-1/2" diameter brass disc with punch mark, stamped "LS 1644" over found 3/4" iron pin in concrete in monument well. Also set four 0.38 Cal. shells in concrete sidewalks for reference points.
