

## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 205.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

Larry D. Hunts

Trail, Oregon

LOCATION:

Northeast quarter of Section 14 in Township 34 South, Range 1 East, WM., Jackson County, Oregon.

**PURPOSE:** 

Locate and monument the north, south, and east boundaries of the northwest quarter of

northeast quarter of Section 14.

PROCEDURE:

An electronic theodolite and distance meter traverse was run between the controlling corners shown on the map. Monuments set on the north/south and east/west centerlines of Section 14 by Filed Survey No. 11234 were used in determining the location for the center 1/4 corner.

At the three 1/16th corners established on this survey,

the following references were taken:

At the CN 1/16 corner, set a 5/8" x 24" iron pin with orange plastic cap marked "R Roberts LS 1656", flush, from which an 8" dia. oak bears N 75° E 32.65 feet. An 8" dia. oak bears S 6° W 26.60 feet. Both trees were double blazed, with "CN 1/16" scribed in the upper blaze, BT" scribed in the lower blaze. Bearing were by hand compass to the bottom center of the tree. distances were measured to a nail and washer at the side center of the tree at the bottom. A punch mark on the northwest side of a steel fence corner post, 3" above the concrete footing, bears S 40° W 0.90 ft. Fences bear north and east from this corner post.

At the E 1/16th corner, between Sections 11 and 14, set x 24" iron pin with orange plastic cap marked "R a 5/8" Roberts LS 1656", in a mound of stone, from which an 8" dia. madrone bears N 2° W 21.53 feet. An 9" dia. oak bears S 69° E 12.27 feet. Both trees were double blazed, with "E 1/16 S 11/14" scribed in the upper blaze, and "BT" scribed in the lower blaze. Bearing were by hand compass to the bottom center of the tree. The distances were measured to a nail and washer at the side center of the tree at the bottom.

At the NE 1/16 corner of Section 14, set a 5/8" x 24" iron pin with orange plastic cap marked "R Roberts LS 1656", 3" deep, from which a 6" dia. fir bears N 34° E 36.72 feet. A 6" dia. cedar bears S 28° E 24.59 feet. Both trees were double blazed, with "NE 1/16" scribed in the upper blaze, and "BT" scribed in the lower blaze. Bearing were by hand compass to the bottom center of the The distances were measured to a nail and washer at the side center of the tree at the bottom. The corner is in the center of Olson Grade Road.
