BASIS OF Bearings based upon Recorded Survey number 9527,

the East line of the NE 1/4 of said Section 25.

PROCEDURE: The N 1/4 corner was searched for, but not found. At the proportioned position between the NW and

NE corners of Section 25, I set:

A 5/8" rebar with a yellow plastic cap marked: "TEMPLIN LS 2359 ".

From which the I scribe the following bearing trees:

A White Oak, 5" diameter bears N 03° E, 50.4 feet, scribed "N1/4S25" "BT".

A Cedar, 26" diameter bears S 75 3/4°W, feet, scribed "N1/4S25" "BT".

I also take the following bearing objects:

A Power pole (804370), bears N 86 1/2° E, 66.75 feet.

A Guy pole (B04371), bears S 62 3/4° E, 66.6 feet.

I then tied the E 1/4, S 1/4, W 1/4 and computed the C 1/4 position, at said point I set:

A 5/8" rebar with a yellow plastic cap marked: "TEMPLIN LS 2359 ".

From which the I scribe the following bearing trees.

A Ponderosa Pine, 42" diameter bears N 40 3/4° E, 246.4 feet, scribed "C1/4S25" "BT".

A Madrone, 27" diameter bears N 85 3/4°E, 237.0

feet, scribed "C1/4S25" "BT".

A White Oak, 32" diameter bears S 52° W, 162.2 feet, scribed "C1/4S25" "BT".

A White Oak, 13" diameter bears N 49° W, 191.1 feet, scribed "C1/4S25" "BT".
