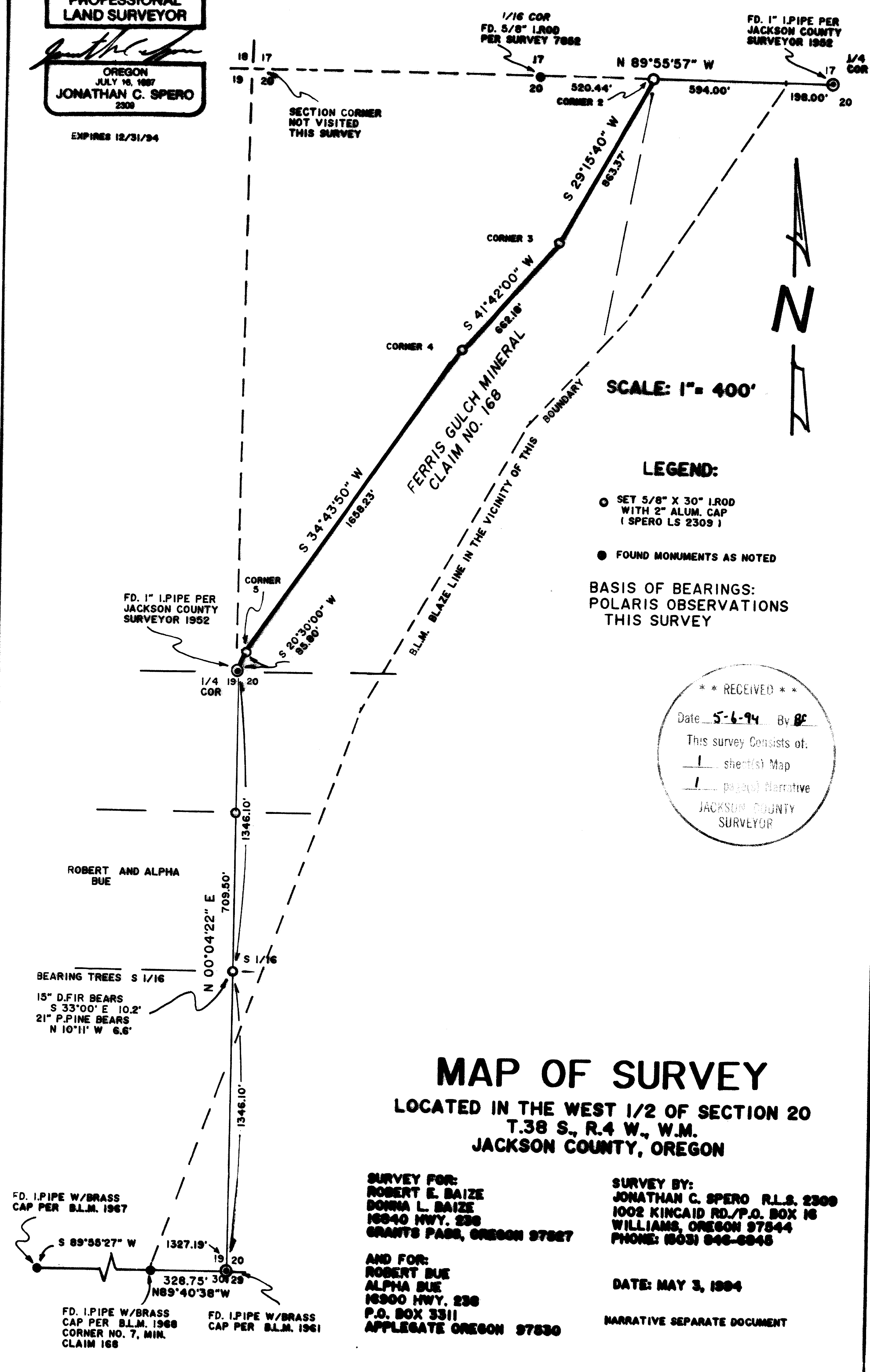

PURPOSE: To monument the Westerly boundary of the Ferris Gulch Mineral Claim No. 168 within the Northwest Quarter of Section 20, property of Robert E. and Donna L. Baize, and to monument the intersection of the West line of Section 20 with the Northerly and Southerly boundaries of property owned by Robert and Alpha Bue.

PROCEDURE: Beginning at the North 1/4 corner for Section 20, (as monumented by Jackson County Surveyor C.Z. Boyden in 1952), I then ran control traverse to the West 1/16th corner (per Survey 7852) to the West 1/4 corner (as monumented by Jackson County Surveyor C.Z. Boyden in 1952), to the Southwest corner of Section 20 (as monumented by B.L.M. in 1961), and to corners on the South line of Section 19 as shown on this Map of Survey.

A thorough search turned up no original evidence for Mineral Claim corners 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 9 or 10, and possible, but inconclusive, evidence in the vicinity of corner 8. Corner 7 was remonumented by the B.L.M. from original evidence in 1968.

As best remaining evidence to reestablish the corners of the Ferris Gulch Mineral Claim No. 168, I held record distances along the Section line from the North 1/4 corner for the position of Mineral Corners 1 and 2, and record bearing and distance from the West 1/4 corner for Mineral Corner 5. I then established, by proportionate measurement, using the method of Broken Boundaries (as per B.L.M. MANUAL Chapter 5-43, also known as the Compass Rule Adjustment), positions for corners 3 and 4.

There is a line of blazed trees in the vicinity of the Southeasterly boundary of Mineral Claim 168. This line was established by the B.L.M. in the late 1960's or early 1970's in the presence of Mr. Ives L. Brown, former owner of the property. Since no firm original evidence exists to establish this boundary, and the blaze line appears to be in a reasonable location for said boundary, no proportioned corners were set and these lines were not surveyed.

Date of Survey: May 3, 1994

Bearings are based on Polaris observations made in the course of this survey.

This narrative accompanies a one page plat.

Bearing trees established this survey and located at the South 1/16th corner common to Sections 19 and 20 are marked with a double blaze and scribed as follows:  
15" diameter douglas fir, scribed "S1/16 S 20 BT"

bears S33°00'E 10.2'

21" diameter ponderosa pine, scribed "S1/16 S 19 BT"

bears N 10°11' W, 6.6'
