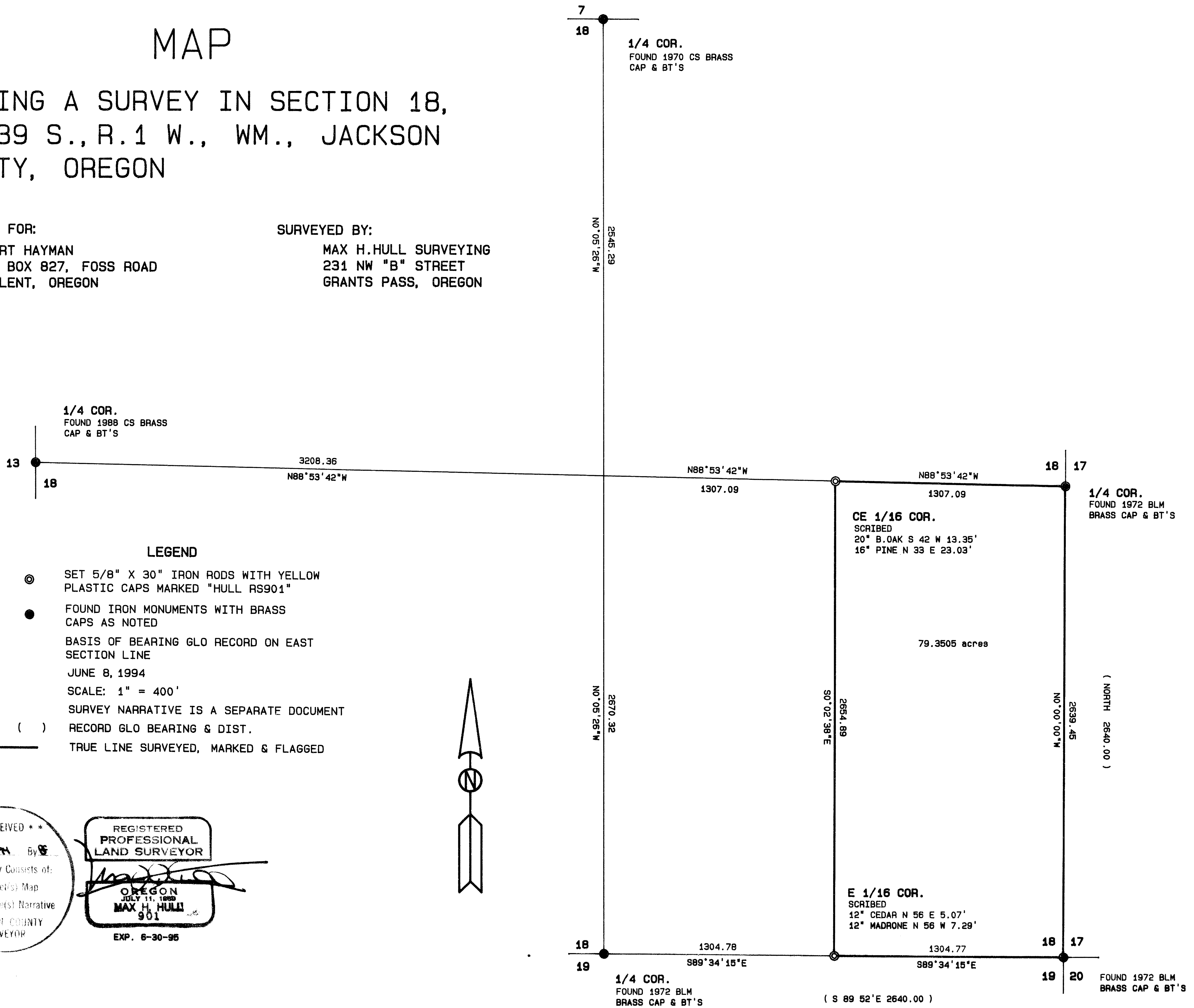

A Fir 13" in diam. North 80-1/2° East 21.1 feet, blaze healed.

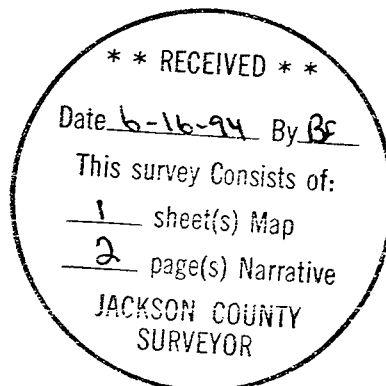
A Fir stump 20" in diam. South 45° East 73.6 feet, blaze healed.

Thence I calculated the subdivision of the Section and the Southeast 1/4 as shown on the map; thence I surveyed and marked true line around the East 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 as shown on the map.

found a 1972 BLM brass cap from which I found
A Fir 10" in diam. North 30° West 14.52 feet,
blaze healed.
A Fir 20" in diam. South 48° East 79.86 feet,
blaze healed.

Thence I traversed to the Southeast Section corner
at which point I found a 1972 BLM brass cap from
which I found

A Fir 15" in diam. North 15-1/2° East 54.78
feet, blaze healed.
A W.Fir 11" in diam. South 7° East 36.96
feet, blaze healed.
A Fir 17" in diam. South 52° West 34.65 feet,
blaze healed.
A Cedar 10" in diam. North 65° West 31.02
feet, blaze healed.

Thence I traversed to the East 1/4 corner at which
point I found a 1972 BLM brass cap from which I
found

A Fir 19" in diam. North 23° East 24.75 feet,
blaze healed.
A Y.Pine 39" in diam. North 42° West 28.38
feet, scribe visible.
A B.Oak 25" in diam. North 70° East 21.12
feet, blaze healed.

Thence I traversed to the West 1/4 corner of
Section 18 only at which point I found a 1988 C.S.
brass cap from which I found

A Y.Pine 75" in diam. South 87°30' East
150.34 feet, scribe visible.
A Y. Pine 20" in diam. North 36°30' East
137.50 feet, scribe visible.
