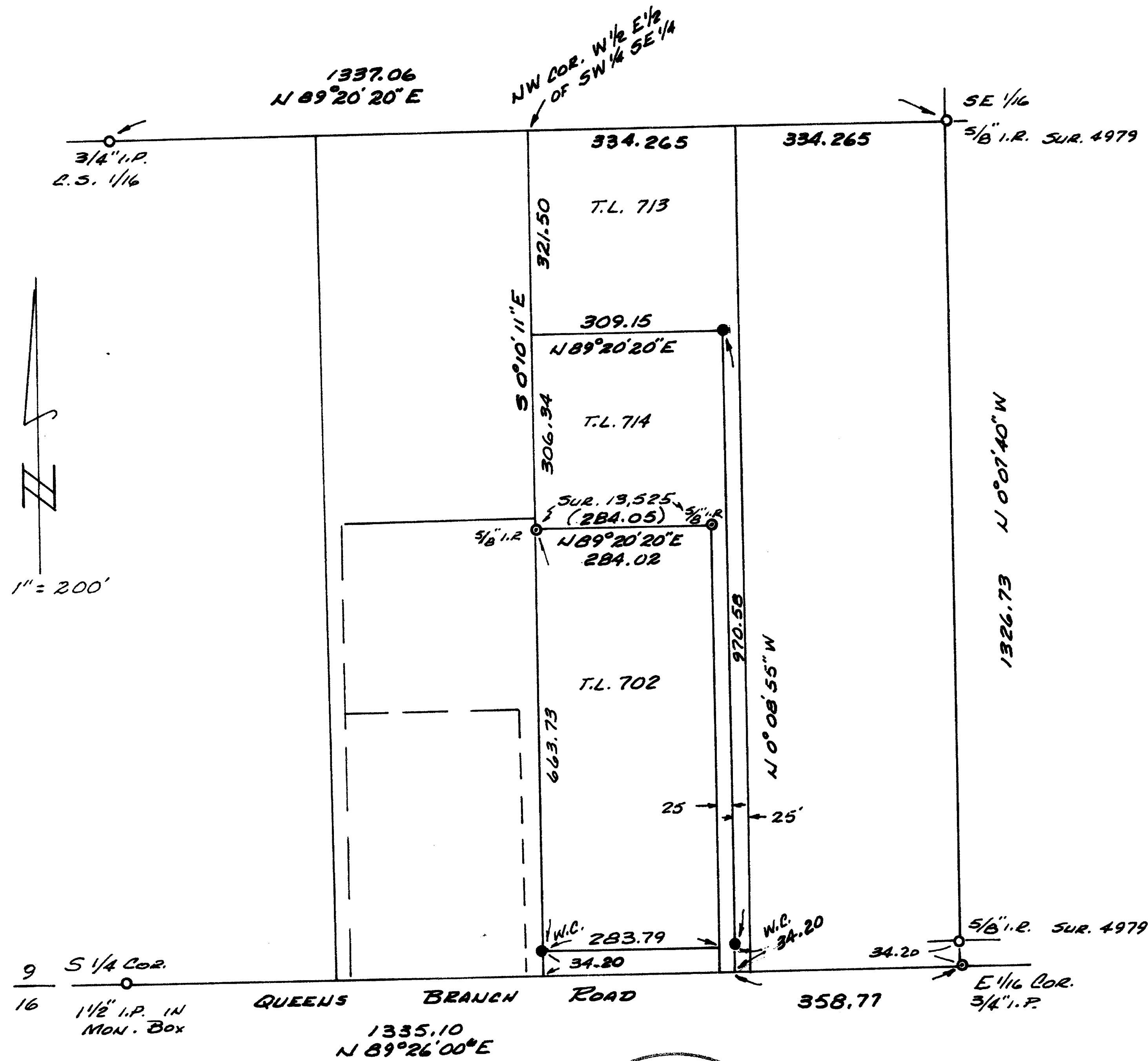

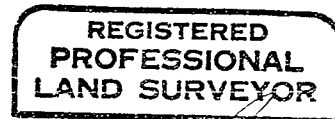
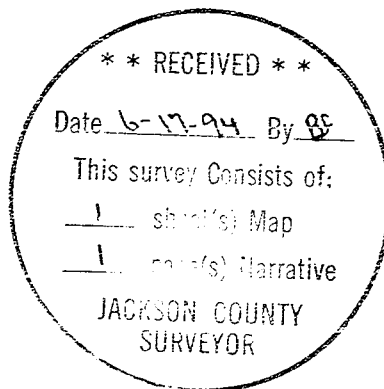
PURPOSE OF SURVEY: To locate and monument the East line of T.L. 714, which is the division line of the flagpole access to T.L.'s 713 and 714. Also, to determine the West line of T.L. 702.

PROCEDURE: Survey No. 13,525 was done to determine the South line of T.L. 714. To do this it was necessary to subdivide the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$. I used measurements from Surveys 7223 for the subdivision.

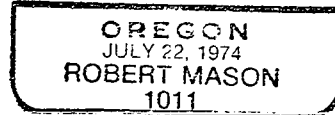
