

## SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

Survey for:

5100 Rogue River Highway Grants Pass, Oregon 97525

Location:

Located in the Northeast and the Northwest Quarter of Section 9, Township 38 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

Purpose:

To survey and monument the Boundary Line Adjustment of Tracts A, B, and C of Instrument Number 92-07129 of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon as shown on the accompanying plat.

Procedure:

In a closed traverse I tied the controlling monuments as shown on the accompanying plat. Because of the ambiguous ties of the subject property and the surrounding deeds to the center line of Old Pacific Highway (U.S. 99) and the subsequent obliteration of said center line in 1953 by the State Highway improvement project caused the boundaries of the subject properties on the Easterly and Westerly sides to be established by a Boundary Line Agreement as shown on the accompanying map. The Northerly boundary was determined from the exclusions as stated in Instrument No. 92-07129 and tied to the inside ELL Corner of D.L.C. 41 and the South line of Lakeside Mobile Home Subdivision as monumented and platted by survey number 10924.
