## At the CS 1/16, I set:

A 5/8" rebar with a yellow plastic cap marked "TEMPLIN LS 2359", from which the following bearing trees: A Black Oak, 12" diameter bears S 6 1/2° W, 21.8 feet, scribed "CS1/16S12" "BT". A Douglas Fir, 8" diameter bears S 70° W, 6.9 feet, scribed "CS1/16S12" "BT".

Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE: To survey the Deed corners of my clients

property and to mark said corners and deed lines, by blazing and painting with flo-red paint, as

shown on accompanying map.

DATE: March 25, 1995

Bearings based upon B.L.M. Official Plat, the BASIS OF

West line of SW 1/4 of Section 12.

I tied the NE and SW corners of Section 12, along PROCEDURE: with the N 1/4, S 1/4, E 1/4 and W 1/4 of said Section 12. I then computed the Section breakdown

, setting deed corners as shown.

At the C 1/4, I set:

A 5/8" rebar with a yellow plastic cap marked "TEMPLIN LS 2359", from which the following

bearing trees:

A Ponderosa Pine, 18" diameter bears S 18° W, 15.5 feet, scribed "C1/4S12" "BT".

A Black Oak, 7" diameter bears East, 23.2 feet, scribed "C1/4S12" "BT".

At the S 1/16 corner on between Sections 11 and 12, I set:

A 5/8" rebar with a yellow plastic cap marked "TEMPLIN LS 2359", from which the following bearing trees:

A Madrona, 12" diameter bears S 2 1/2° E, 24.7 feet, scribed "S1/16S12" "BT".

A Douglas Fir, 6" diameter bears S 27° W, 14.8 feet, scribed "S1/16S11" "BT".
