

PURPOSE:

To monument tract described in Inst. No. 94-25029 O.R. and to monument calculated positions for the corners of tract described in Inst. No. 95-

Ø1441 O.R..

Also to blaze and paint certain boundaries as shown on the annexed

map.

PROCEDURE:

The boundaries to tract described in

Inst. No. 94-25029 O.R. were monumented as shown on the annexed map from controls established on Filed Survey No. 13850.

A position for the NE corner of Section 14 was computed utilizing measured EDM distances on unrecorded Forest Services surveys as shown. The Forest Service has a series of independent unrecorded surveys around Section 14 where they ran between corners and marked the lines. These surveys are not tied together by bearing (the angles at the corners were not turned) but the distances are good EDM distances, some of which were checked on Filed Survey No. 13850.

For the purpose of marking the boundaries of tract described Inst. No. 95-01441 O.R. for logging it was not deemed necessary to go to the expense of making a field tie to NE corner of Section 14 with the Forest Service distances available. The calculated positions for the corners of said
