

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

Survey for:

Delbert Cook, Et. Al. 3800 Colver Road

Phoenix, Oregon 97535

Location:

Located in the Northeast Quarter of Section 16, Township 38 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon

Purpose:

To survey and monument those tracts described in Instrument Nos. 95-08442, 95-08444, 95-08445 of the Official Records of Jackson County, Oregon

Procedure:

Utilizing previously established control and establishing additional control using global positioning satellite observations and observations with a Sokkia Set 4 Total Station and S.D.R. 33 Data Collector, I tie the controlling monuments and set the tract corners as shown on the accompanying plat. In establishing the South boundary as described in Volume 243, Page 118 of the deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon, I used the Deed calls East and West. The South line of Volume 584, Page 87, said Records, is parallel with the South line of Donation Land Claim No. 42. This call creates an overlap of the two tracts thereby shortening the deed distance on the East line of said tract. The variable width right of way described in Instrument No. 93-13360 was calculated per the deed calls and rotated to the Northerly tangent of Colver Road as shown. This tangent was used after consultation with the Jackson County Department of Public Works as it was established with direct ties to the found monuments. The Southerly end of the Southerly tangent being a calculated position as shown. During the performance of a previous survey by this office, filed as survey number 13709, a one inch square bolt was found and tied at the apparent P.I. of Colver road and used for the Northerly alignment of said road. Subsequent survey information being obtained a 5/8 inch iron pin was found and tied at the P.I. comparing the data of the two points and record information it was determined that the original one inch bolt was not the proper location for the P.I. and the 5/8 inch pin more closely matches the record information. The relationship of the two monuments is shown on the accompanying plat.
