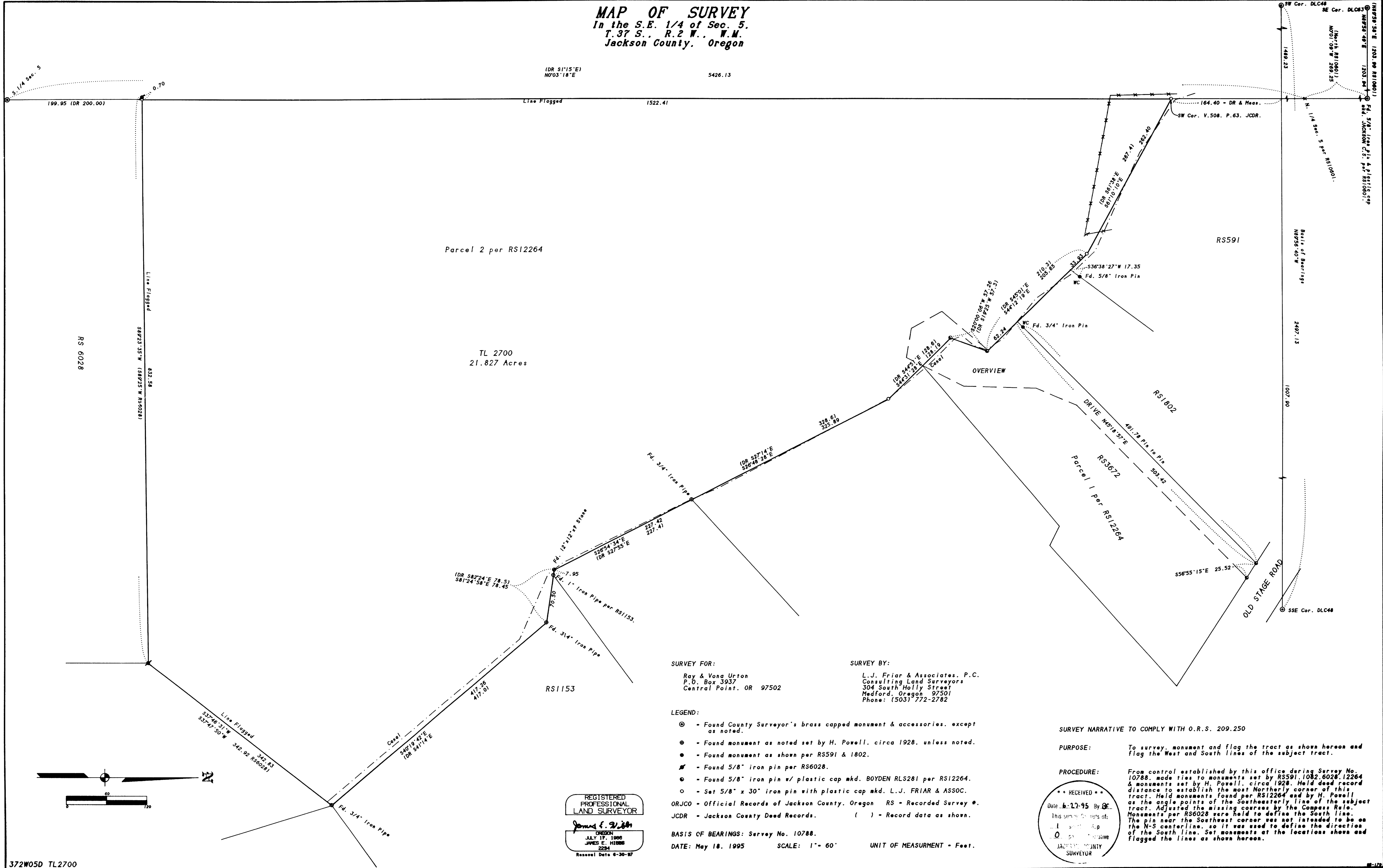


MAP OF SURVEY

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH O.R.S. 209.250

PURPOSE: To survey, monument and flag the tract as shown hereon and flag the West and South lines of the subject tract.

PROCEDURE: From control established by this office during Survey No. 10788, made ties to monuments set by RS591, 1082, 6028, 12264 & monuments set by H. Powell, circa 1928. Held deed record distance to establish the most Northerly corner of this tract. Held monuments found per RS12264 and by H. Powell as the angle points of the Southeastery line of the subject tract. Adjusted the missing courses by the Compass Rule. Monuments per RS6028 were held to define the South line. The pin near the Southwest corner was not intended to be on the NS centerline, so it was used to define the direction of the South line. Set monuments at the locations shown and flagged the lines as shown hereon.
