

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

PURPOSE:

To monument that property described in Volume 156, Page 273 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon, being in Block 13, of the Original Town (now City) of Medford.

PROCEDURE:

There are no street centerline monuments for any of the Streets surrounding Block No. 13. The following controls were used to establish the street centerlines:

The iron pin in monument case at the centerline of Eighth and Central.

A lead plug set 1.00 foot southwesterly and southeasterly from the southerly corner of Block 12, as established by C.Z. Boyden.


A copper rivet with center punch set 1.00 foot Northwesterly and southwesterly from the mostwesterly corner of Block 3 as established by C.Z. Boyden.

The centerline of the main street tangent through the original town as referenced by lead plugs set in concrete at each end produced, as established by C.Z. Boyden.

From said controls, surrounded the Block establishing the Westerly, Southerly and Easterly boundaries of the subject property by proportionate measurement.

The control for the Northerly property boundary was the location of the Northerly wall face of the Old Post office Building as referred to in said Deed Record. This was located by careful inspection of the building wall and further verified by a previous survey by Mr. C.Z. Boyden who prepared the description now recorded in Volume 265, Page 321 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon.
