

in Volume 306, Page 423 for PARALLELISM with Beach Street should revert back to Volume 288, Page 495 of the Deed Records. However, the bearing along the Westerly boundary line of Volume 306, Page 423, is nowhere near the resultant bearing derived from Volume 288, Page 495 for Beach Street. In lieu of the call for being parallel with Beach Street, I have elected to hold the record angle from the South line of the Matthews Addition in order to establish the Southwest corner of Volume 306, Page 423 of the deed records. The deed record Bearings along the South line of the Matthews Addition and the West line of Volume 306, Page 423 have always been consistent throughout the descriptions of various other deeds. Bearings recited throughout the many other deeds of record in this area do not retain this same consistency; therefore, my decision was to utilize that which I felt was a better known and consistent value with the original scrivener's intent.

There is no way anyone knows for sure that the found 3/4 inch iron rod, in the vicinity of the Southwest corner of Volume 306, Page 423, was in fact set to mark the corner of that tract of land. With no deed reference to said 3/4 inch iron rod, and no other supporting evidence, prior to Filed Survey No. 9292, I find it necessary to reject the 3/4 inch iron rod as a controlling factor.

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209,250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

LOCATION:

Situated in the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 9 and the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 16, Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Base and Meridian,

Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To establish centerline monuments and/or centerline WITNESS CORNER MONUMENTS for Beach Street, from Henry Street to the Southerly line of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 16, Township 39 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Base and Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon. Also, a 10 foot wide Sanitary Sewer Easement which was the initial motivator of this project. It is situated over, across and through Tax Lots 5100 and 5200, Assessor's Map 39-1E-16AA. The land owner is Steven G. Willing and Karen Bates Willing of 725 Beach Street, Ashland, Oregon 97520.

After construction of the re-routed sanitary sewer line, the land owner of Tax Lot 5200 requested that the property line between Tax Lots 5200 and 5300 be identified at the West right of way line of Beach Street. Thus, the 'Amended Survey and Narrative' as set forth on the accompanying map.

PROCEDURE:

The control for this survey was started from previously established points by Surveyor Swain many years ago, while in private surveying practice. A portion of this control line was re-surveyed to verify the accuracy of these control points.

Monuments per Filed Survey No. 9292 and other monuments of an unrecorded nature were tied to our field control traverse. In evaluating the procedure for Filed Survey No. 9292, I take exception to the holding of a found 3/4 inch iron rod for the position of the Southwest corner of Volume 306, Page 423 of the Deed Records of Jackson County, Oregon. In reading the description within Volume 306, Page 423, I find NO call for monuments. Further, I find a call for the West boundary line of Volume 306, Page 423 to be PARALLEL with Beach Street and not with Liberty Street as so indicated on Filed Survey No. 9292. The problem, as I see it, is that Beach Street, Easterly of and contiguous to the Easterly boundary line of Volume 306, Page 423 was deeded in Volume 288, Page 495 on the 1st day of August, 1947. Volume 306, Page 423 was created on the 19th day of December, 1947; therefore, the call
