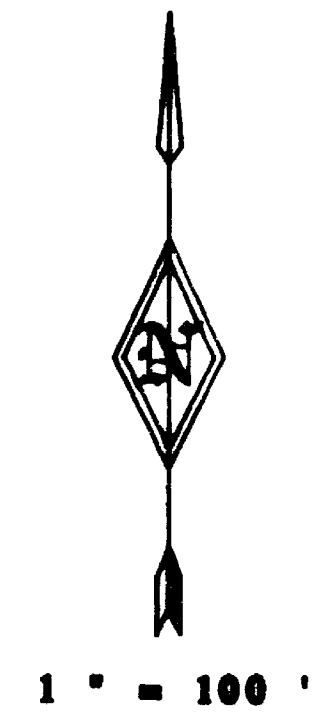
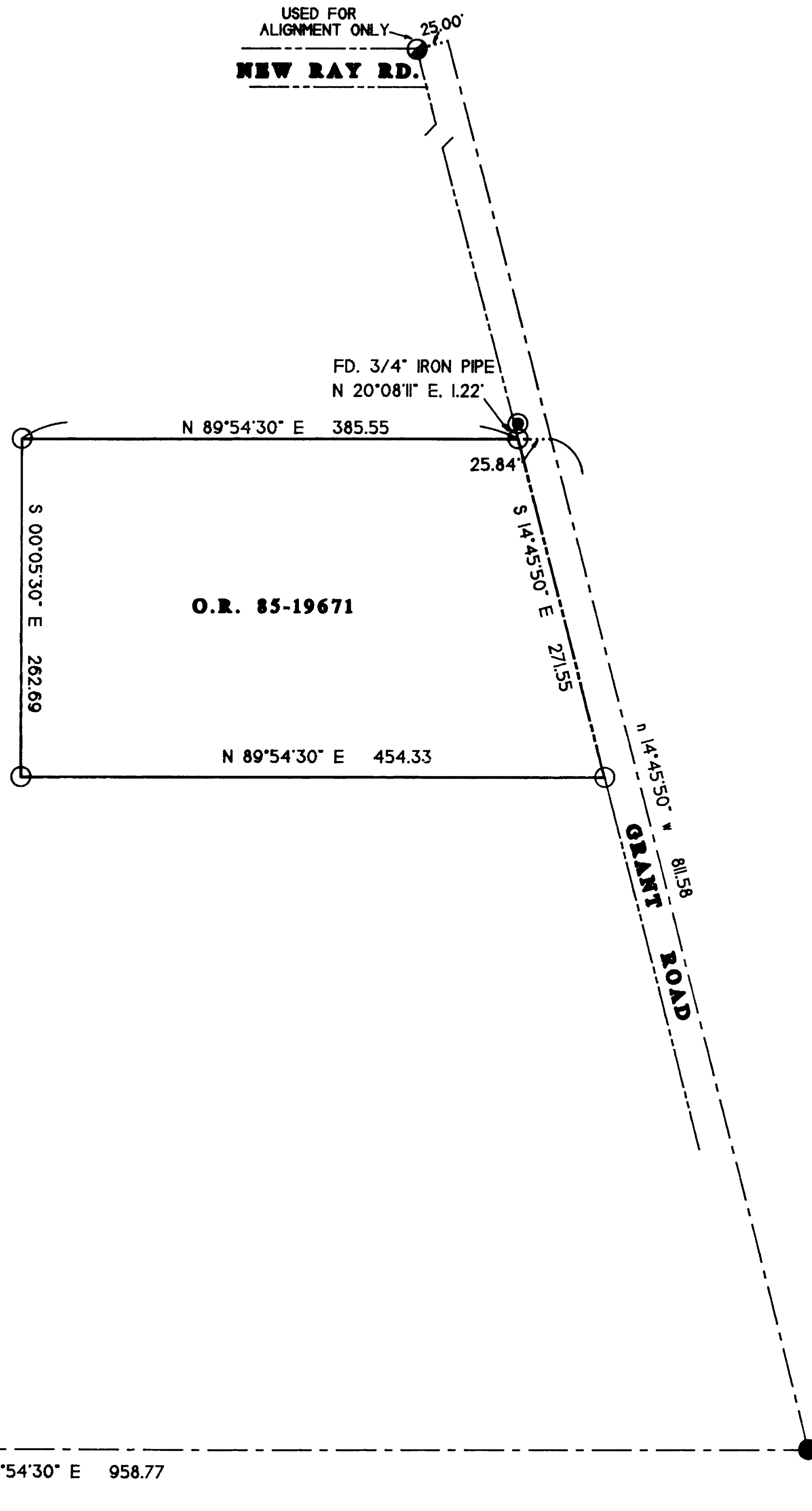


SURVEY NARRATIVE

PURPOSE: To survey and monument the outside boundary of O.R. 85-19671, at my clients request.

PROCEDURE: Tied the NE corner of D.L.C number 44 and a found 5/8" iron rod, 10" deep at the intersection of Beall Lane and Grant Road. For the alignment of Grant Road I used a found 5/8" iron rod set on "Grant Acres" and said intersection of Beall Lane and Grant Road. Computed deed corners and set, as shown.
