

Monument most Southerly and Westerly boundaries of tract described in Inst. No. 94-34370 O.R. and also to blaze and paint said boundaries.

PROCEDURE:

Utilizing EDM equipment made field

ties to monuments indicated as found. A position for the SE corner of Section 6 (being monumented with a 1" G.I. pipe and brass cap witness corner set by County Surveyor) was calculated using the 1974 BLM survey data and field ties to the South quarter corner and the South onesixteenth corner for control. This calculation could leave the monumented SE onesixteenth corner off slightly East and West (the North-South position being determined by the BLM South one sixteenth corner and the monumented CS onesixteenth corner). The prime purpose for setting the SE onesixteenth corner was to mark the line West to the CS onesixteenth corner which will not be affected by not making a physical tie to the SE section corner.
