N.Dow, a duly registered Surveyor of the State of Oregon, being first duly sworn, do hereby certify that I have correctly surveyed and marked with proper monuments as provided by law the tract of land hereon shown and the said plat is a correct representation of the same, and the following is an accurate description of the boundary lines:

Written narrative to accompany plat for survey NO.

Survey for Mr. A.C. Pierce, Medford, Oregon.

Purpose to resubdivide Blocks 1, 3 and 4 Bel Air Heights a subdivision in Section 27, T. 37S. R X W. Jackson County, Oregon.

Date of survey april and May, 1960.

Proceedurs: First a tentative plat was made and studied, both on paper and on the ground, then changes was made and it was re-drawn.

This tentative plat was then submitted by Mr. Pierce, along with

contour map, made from air photos.

The first step was to re-coordinate the boundaries for this part of the original plat, for this purpose a field tie was made along the southerly line of Princeton Way across Harvard Place, and the computations made. At the same time it was expected that the original pins in this area, due to the type of soil might be subject to small amounts of shifting, due to freezing and drying. A check was made starting at the original point of the Original Bel Air Heights and running all points west along the north line of Cherry Lane, very excellent results was obtained and the extra pins was set in for the division of the original lots.

Next many man hours of time was consumed computing all lot lengths and co-ordinates for mostlot points, along with bearings and distances, especially those on the arcs of intersecting curves. For check purposes cut throughs was made form the outside boundary through lot lines to the outside boundary on the opposite side to eliminate errors.

Wuth this map completed we then picked up at the concrete monument on the south line of Lot 36 Block 3, and centinued setting points along Cherry Lane and Harvard Place as far as Princeton Way. Then all points, original and new was re run, checked and set on the west line of Robles Avenue. Then all points necessary was established from Robles Avenue along Yale Drive and around Princeton Way to Harvard Place. We then set all inside points for Block 3 as shown on the plat.

The original pin at the northeast corner of Block 4 was bent over and had to be re set for line and distance. We then completed block 4, by finding and checking original points and setting the new ones required.

Block One was started by by rechecking the boundaries of Lot 5, then we established all points and checked the original ones along the north line of Block 1 along Princeton Way. We then ran from Harvard Place along the southwesterly line of Block 1 and completed that line to Princeton Way. We then set all interior points required to complate Block 1 as shown on the plat.

The new concrete monument with tablet was poured on the north line of Cherry Lane at the curve point in the street right of way which makes for easy establishment of the line from the original concrete monument at the southeast corner of Bel Air Heights Original Plat.

From the information thus computed, checked, run in the Efter N for re-check, the final plat was then made and submitted ND SURVEYOR
