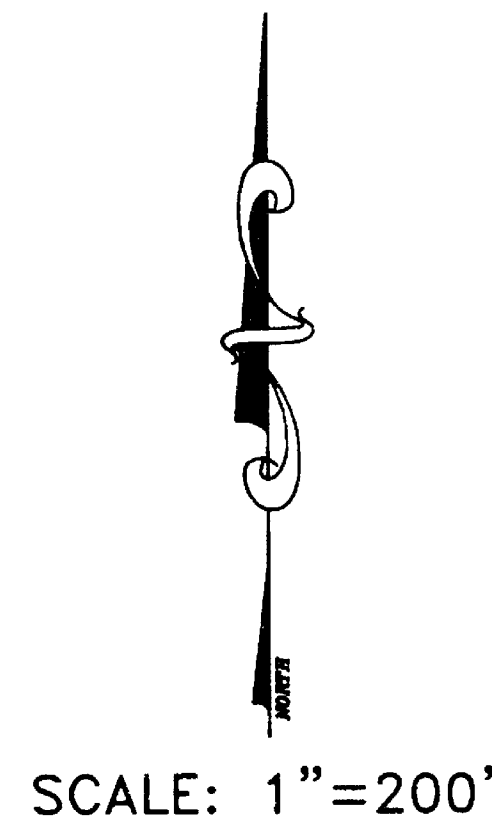

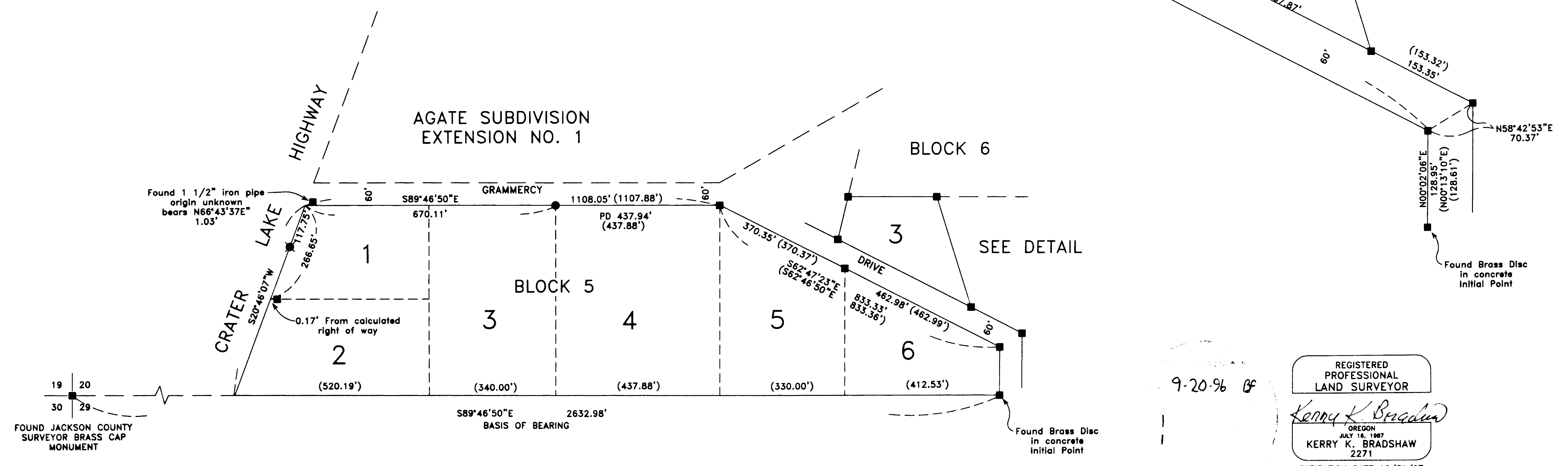
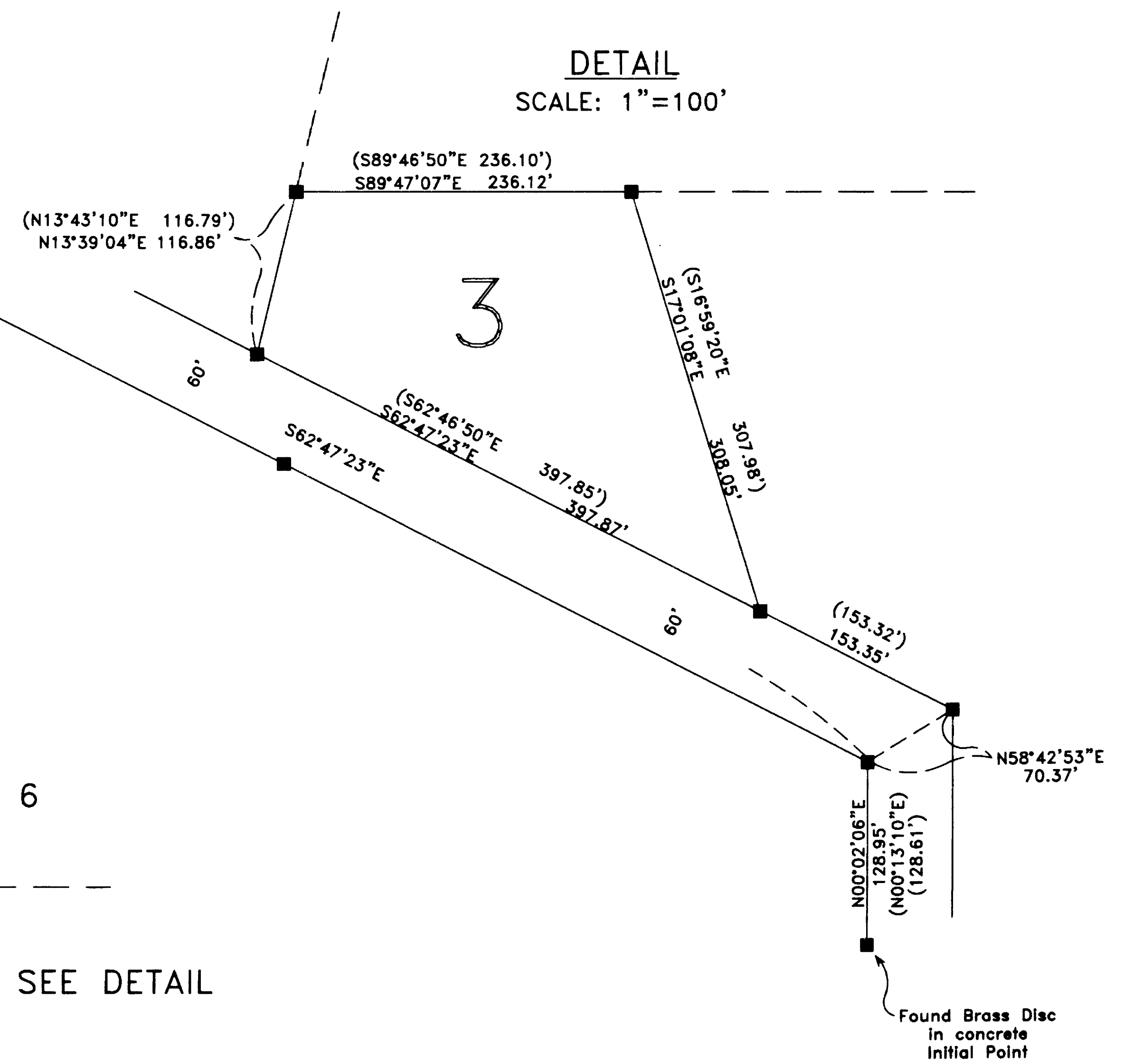

LOCATION: Agate Subdivision Extension No. 1, Township 36 South,
Range 1 West, Section 20, Willamette Meridian, Jackson
County, Oregon.

DATE: July 10, 1996

PURPOSE: To remonument the northwest corner of Lot 4, Block 5;
to locate or remonument the boundary of Lot 3, Block 6,
Agate Subdivision Extension 1.

PROCEDURE: Existing monumentation per Agate Subdivision, Extension
No. 1 was recovered and included in a control traverse
using a Pentax PTSIII total station. An analysis of
the field data was made and mapped as shown on the
accompanying survey plat.

The northwest corner of Lot 4, Block 5 was reset at t
proportionate distance along the right of way line of
Grammercy Drive. Said right of way line was controlled
by holding the found monument at the east terminus and
using plat bearing, which is parallel with the section
line on the south boundary. The west end of the
Grammercy Drive right of way, being Crater Lake
Highway, was established by holding the found Oregon
State Highway Division monument and using the original
plat bearing along the highway right of way. Although
much desired, a more detailed and thorough retracement
of this right of way was not within the scope of this
survey.

The northwest corner of Lot 4, Block 5 was set at
proportionate position.
