

SURVEY NARRATIVE TO COMPLY WITH PARAGRAPH 209.250 OREGON REVISED STATUTES

SURVEY FOR:

Walt Marquess

Medford, Oregon 97504

LOCATION:

The N.E. 1/4 of Section 29, Township 37 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, City of Medford, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To adjust the common line between two parcels owned by the client.

PROCEDURE:

The descriptions of these parcels are tied to the Northeast Corner of Block 3, of the Extension of Siskiyou Heights Addition to the City of Medford. This point was found, and although the monument had been bent, the vertical portion fit well with other monuments found in the area. The descriptions then make a call to a 5/8" iron pin on the westerly right-of-way of Windsor Avenue. This monument was found in good condition. From this point the descriptions go westerly, parallel with the centerline of East Main Street, to a 5/8" iron pin on the westerly described line of Volume 150, Page 74, Jackson County Deed Records. I was unable to find this monument so I used record distances from Filed Survey No. 3053 and Volume 158, Page 74 to establish the location of this line. A 5/8" iron pin from filed Survey No. 2055 was found near the Southwest corner of the two parcels. There is no mention in the narrative of that survey or in the deeds of the two surveyed parcels (which are southerly of the adjusted parcels) of the westerly line of Volume 158, Page 74. I don't believe that the pin was intended to be on said westerly line and did not use it to establish that line. The description of the northerly parcel being adjusted had a bearing call on its southerly line that did not fit the other calls in the parcel descriptions. I held the record distance along the west line at Windsor Avenue as the correct call and this matched well with the southerly parcel description.

BASIS OF BEARING:

The centerline of East Main Street between the intersection with Richmond Avenue and the intersection with Windsor Avenue.
