

LOCATION:

Southeast 1/4 of Southwest 1/4 of Section 9, Township 39 South, Range 1 East, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To survey and monument Lots 1, 2, and 3; Block 1, of Bell Subdivision.

PROCEDURE:

Using a Nikon AG20 total station, the South 1/4 corner and west 1/16 corner, as well as found monuments per Filed Surveys 5582, 8303, and the original plat of Bell Subdivision, were incorporated in a control traverse. The collected data was analyzed and the parcels monumented as shown on the accompanying map.

Measurements revealed that the west boundary of Bell Subdivision as monumented and shown on the original plat, was approximately 2.5 feet westerly of the location as set forth in Volume 47, Page 184 of Official Deed Records, said Volume and Page being the creating device of Guthrie Street.

Found monuments along Friendship Street within Bell Subdivision, including along the area of the cul-de-sac were analyzed in an attempt to determine originality and intent as to the position of the right-of-way as first laid out. The fact that the found monuments included large and small diameter pipes as well as iron pins, although normally uncommon, was an accepted practice standard for the surveyor involved. Measured distance between found monuments along or near the north line of Friendship Street matched the record plat distance and had a best fit relationship to found monuments around the cul-de-sac. It was decided to hold these found monuments as original and the cul-de-sac was positioned as shown on the map. It can be noted that the found 3/4" iron pipe controls the east-west location of the cul-de-sac. The north-south location of the right-ofway was established by holding the 1" pipe on the west and proportioning the south-east corner of Block 1 on the east, thus avoiding an angled right-of-way line.

Lot corners along the north line of the subdivision were proportioned and the cul-de-sac was monumented per plat record, holding the indicated radius and arc lengths.

South line of Section 9, from the South 1/4 corner to the West 1/16 corner as shown on Filed Survey No. 5582.
