PROCEDURE:

The property corners of the subject

premises have been previously monumented on surveys of record, Filed Survey Nos. 2189, 3584 and 4912 except for the most Southerly corner which falls within vacated First Street and the corner which bears North 22° 42' 50" East, 100.02 feet therefrom.

Some of the original monuments set on Filed Survey No. 2189 were apparently destroyed and reset, along with new additional monuments, on Filed Survey No. 3584. This was also the case with Filed Survey No. 4912 where some remonumentation took place as well as some new additional corners set and this is also the case in this Survey, the 2 corner not previously monumented as above mentioned were set along with 5 corners being remonumented. The 2 corner monuments indicated on the accompanying map as having "found concrete placed around pins" were apparently disturbed in the process of "placing the concrete" and will be considered witness corners to the true property corner.
