Controls used to accomplish this were SW corner and the South and West quarter corners of Section 9 as re-established by the County Surveyor along with the center quarter corner which was established on Filed Survey No. 2746 and the West 1/16 corner monumented on Filed Survey No. 7618. The existing centerline of the private road was monumented as shown on the accompanying map and the boundary between Parcel Nos. 1 and 2 was located per the clients direction and the County.

### Bearing trees marked:

At the South 1/16 corner common to Sections 8 and 9 scribed a 4" white oak "S 1/16 S9-BT" which bears South 39° 97' East, 11.3'. Scribed a 6" white oak "S 1/16 S9-BT" which bears North 61° 55' E, 32.8'. A fence corner N-S-E-W bears North 27° 45' West, 30.5'.
