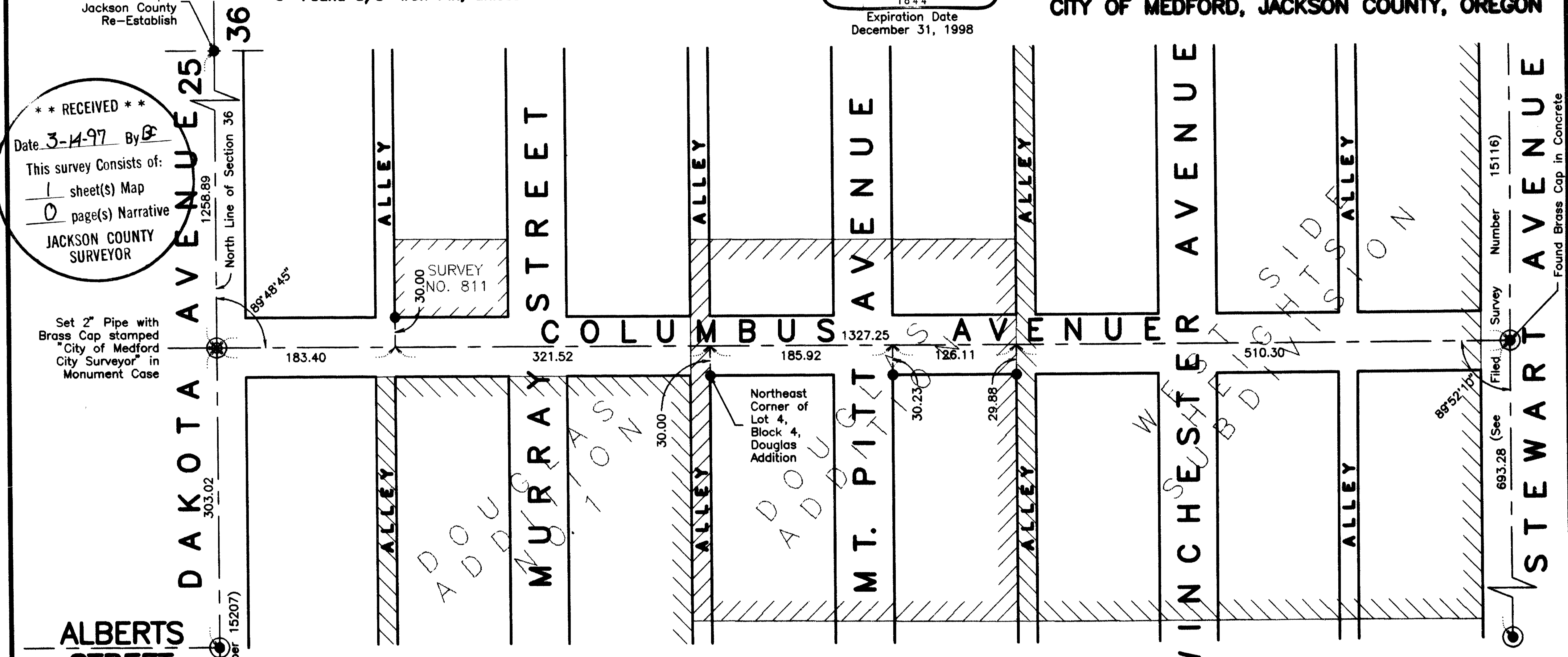

PURPOSE: To monument centerline of Columbus Avenue and the north line of Section 36.

PROCEDURE: The centerline of Columbus Avenue was established by holding the monument at the northwest corner of Survey Number 811 and the northeast corner of Lot 4, Block 4, Douglas Addition. This was the best alignment that could be determined from the monuments found along the Right-of-Way of Columbus Avenue.
