the North boundary of T.36S., R.2E.). A proportionate position for the North Quarter Corner of Section 6 using the Ford Survey and his tie to the Ives and Hyde Quarter Corner would place the Quarter Corner approximately 37 feet East from the proportionate position determined from the Ives and Hyde distances. A badly burned oak stump was found near the record location for the original SW Ives and Hyde bearing tree from our monumented position with a small part of relief scribed visible. The stump had been disturbed by dozer work, the original position could not be determined.

### BEARING TREES:

% corner common to Section 5 and 6 (corner falls in an East-West fence line). The original Southeast pine bearing tree, now down with only the pitch center remaining with "BT" scribe found lying along side, bears S 28° E, 34.49 feet to the stump hole.

A 9" black oak scribed "% S-BT" bears N 72° 06' W, 31.3' A 10" white oak scribed "% S-BT" bears N 21° 11' E, 38.8' A 11" black oak scribed "% S-BT" bears S 38° 19' E, 31.9' A 9" white oak scribed "% S-BT" bears S 49° 33' W, 30.1'

North % corner Section 6 (proportionate position). Found original Southwest bearing tree, now a badly burned oak stump with small piece of relief scribe visible. Stump has been disturbed by dozer work, the original position could not be determined well enough to set corner back from.

PROCEDURE:

Ran control traverse around the

section and computed offset from traverse points to the section line where section line is the clients property line.

Ran true line on boundaries as mentioned under "purpose" above.

Set East % corner from original evidence and set the North and South Quarter Corners at proportionate distance after diligent search for original evidence. The North Quarter Corner was set midway between the Northwest and Northeast corners of Section 6 as set in 1854 by Ives and Hyde and on line between the Southwest and Southeast Corner of Section 31 as set in 1855 by Ford. The Ford Survey is a retracement of the Ives and Hyde Eighth Standard Parallel (corners along the Eighth Standard Parallel in this area are treated as angle points since the survey of the South boundary of T.35S., R.2E. was a retracement of the survey of
