feet

A 11" laurel scribed "C ¼ - BT" bears N 83° 58' E, 30.4 feet

Center South 1/16 Corner

A 14" laurel scribed "CS 1/16 - BT" bears N 21° 48' W, 42.0 feet

A 7" white oak scribed "CS 1/16 - BT" bears S 73° 53' W, 34.7 feet
