AP-1 Set 5/8" x 30" iron rod with yellow plastic cap marked "WYTCHERLEY LS 2724". From which I scribed B.T.'S:

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closure of 0.18 ft. One of these traverses was used to monument and mark the lines for Exception "c". Beginning with the monuments tied per Survey no. 12487, I calculated the centerline of exception "a" southerly to 0+00 of the spillway. The distance from this calculated point to the SW cor. of sec. 31 disagreed with the legal description tie. The northerly end of Exception "a" is tied by the legal description to the east 1/4 cor. of sec. 30. I ran a traverse to this 1/4 cor. to check the total distance between the east 1/4 cor. of section 30 and the SW cor. of section 31. The measured distance is 17.29 ft. Greater than the calculated description distance. I then obtained a copy of an as constructed map from the Pacific Power & Light Company Hydro Station at Prospect to determine the location of 0+00 of the spillway. (drawing no. G2 PF-37148, PROSPECT PROJECT 2630). After making ties to the spillway and the canal edges I calculated the intersection of the centerline of the spillway and the centerline of the canal for 0+00 of the spillway from this point the centerline and the Northwesterly boundary of Exception "a" was calculated northerly across the north section line of section 31. I then rotated the bearings of these points so that angle point no. "AP-1" is on a projection of the line formed by the monuments tied per surv. no. 12487. This locates the calculated centerline of exception "a" very close to the physical centerline of the canal at the points tied.

When calculating the Westerly Boundary of Exception "d" and the Westerly boundary of Exception "a" by starting both from the description ties to the SW cor. of sec. 31 then calculating northerly the NW corner of Exception "d" is within a few 1/100 of a foot of being on the most southerly line of the Westerly boundary of Exception "a". This is also shown on the as built drawing obtained from the power Co. After calculating the Westerly boundary of Exception "d", I rotated the points, holding point no. "AP-15" so that the NW cor. of Exception "d" is on the most Southerly line of the Westerly boundary of Exception "a".

LOCATION: Sections 30 and 31, Township 32 South, Range 3 East, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon.

PURPOSE:

To Survey, Monument, and mark the lines of the following found in Volume 531, Page 204, Official Deed Records of Jackson county, Oregon;

- 1. The Westerly boundary of Exception "d" from Parcel 3, beginning at it's point of beginning on the section line between Sections 31 and 6 running to it's intersection with the northwesterly boundary of exception "a".
- 2. The Northwesterly Boundary of Exception "a" from Parcel 3, beginning at it's intersection with the westerly boundary of exception "d" running to it's intersection with the section line between Sections 31 and 30.
- The North, East, and the South Boundaries of Exception "c" from Parcel 3.
- The lines beginning at the SW corner of Exception "c", South along the 4. Section line to the SW Corner of Section 31, then east along the Section line to the point of beginning of Exception "d".

PROCEDURE:

Beginning at the 1/4 cor. common to sections 30 and 31 I did a closed loop traverse to the SW Cor. of Sec. 31. From this traverse I tied the monuments shown on the plat per County Survey No. 12487 and the canal ties across from these monuments. I ran two traverses from different points of the main traverse to tie the witness cor. to the south 1/4 cor. of sec. 31. The ties miss-closed by 0.06 ft.

Two traverses were also ran to the west 1/4 cor. of sec. 31 with a miss-
