

The new adjusted boundaries were located as directed by the clients.

At the SE 1/16 corner to Section 19 set a 1"  $\times$  36" G.I. pipe with plastic cap from which.

A 7" white oak scribed "SE 1/16 - BT" bears N 73° 42' W, 18.5'.

A 14" white oak scribed "SE 1/16 - BT" bears S 11° 19' W, 18.2'. The corner falls 100' ± Northerly from a small reservoir and on the Easterly edge of the Westerly creek running into reservoir.

At the CW 1/16 corner to Section 19 set a 1" x 36" G.I. pipe with plastic cap from which:

A 11" black oak scribed "CW 1/16 - BT" bears N 52  $\circ$  Ø4' E, 9.4'.

A 9" white oak scribed "CW 1/16 - BT" bears S 5° 16' E, 20.8'.

At the SW 1/16 corner to Section 19 set a 1" x 36" G.I. pipe with plastic cap from which:

A 10" white oak scribed "SW 1/16 - BT" bears N 52° 15' W, 78.6'.

A 12" white oak scribed "SW 1/16 - BT" bears N 27°  $\emptyset$ 5' E, 158.7'.

By description the tract described in Inst. No.  $8\mathfrak{G}$ -23511 O.R. (McDonough to W.M. Associates dated Oct. 15, 1980) Laps the tract described in Inst. No. 89-18353 O.R. (McDonough to Hollander dated Sept. 1, 1966, a late recording). The common boundary between the two tracts was monumented as described in Inst. No. 89-18353 O.R. because of senior status of Inst. No. 89-18353.
