



TO MARK AND POST THE BOUNDARIES OF

SUPERIOR LUMBER CO. LAND IN THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SAID SECTION 10, AS SHOWN ON THE PLAT TO ACCOMPANY THIS NARRATIVE.

PROCEDURE:

A SEARCH OF RECORDS REVEALED THAT THE

EXTERIOR CORNERS OF SAID SECTION 10 NEEDED

FOR CONTROL OF THIS SURVEY WERE

REESTABLISHED FROM ORIGINAL EVIDENCE OR

PROPORTIONATE MEASUREMENT.

I RAN A CLOSED TRAVERSE TYING TO THE

CORNERS NEEDED FOR CONTROL OF THIS SURVEY.

A POSITION FOR THE CENTER ONE-QUARTER CORNER WAS CALCULATED. THE INTERIOR LINES NEEDED WERE THEN RAN BEGINNING AND ENDING ON THE EXTERIOR TRAVERSE OF SAID SECTION.

### CORNERS SET THIS SURVEY

ALL MEASUREMENTS TO BEARING TREES ARE TO THE CENTER OF TREE AT BASE UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED. BEARING TREES HAVE A BRASS WASHER MARKED LS1086 NAILED TO LOWER FACE.

CENTER ONE-QUARTER CORNER SECTION 10 TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH RANGE 1 EAST. AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE NORTH-SOUTH CENTERLINE AND THE EAST-WEST CENTERLINE OF SECTION 10, I SET A 5/8 BY 30 INCH REBAR WITH A 2 INCH DIAMETER ALUM. CAP EXPOSED FOUR INCHES MARKED:
